- I, A. J. Siddiqui, being first duly sworn upon oath, depose and state as follows:
- 1. I am a CPA operating as A.J. Siddiqui CPA, with an office at 2429 University Avenue West, #100, St. Paul, MN 55114.
- 2. I am very familiar with the business operations and financial affairs and financial conditions of the above-named Debtor.
- 3. It is the desire of the Debtor to retain me as an accountant to assist the Debtor in its proceedings under Title 11 of the United States Code. I will be providing accounting assistance to the Debtor and will be providing payroll service, preparing monthly financial reports and will be helping with respect to accounting, taxes, Medicare Cost Reporting and financial issues as well as preparing the US Trustee Reports.
- 4. Due to my knowledge of the Debtor's business operations and financial affairs, the Debtor believes that I am best suited to aid the Debtor in these Bankruptcy proceedings. The Debtor has no accounting staff, payroll staff or bookkeeping staff in its employ. All of the Debtor's payroll tax and accounting functions are provided by my office.

- 5. A.J. Siddiqui CPA was owed \$4,840.00 at the time of the commencement of the Chapter 11 case. I have agreed to waive the amount owed. I do not hold any interest that is adverse to the Debtor or the Debtor's Estate and I should, therefore, be considered a "disinterested party" within the meaning of and pursuant to Section 327 of the **United States Bankruptcy Code**.
- 6. To the best of my knowledge, I do not have any conflict of interest and I have no connection with the Debtor, creditors, or any other party in interest, their respective attorneys and accountants or the United States Trustee, with the exception of my representation of Debtor herein.
- 7. In conjunction with services to be rendered on behalf of the Debtor, I will be charging the Debtor \$3000.00 for the 2017 year end work and \$2500.00 per month for the monthly payroll, Medicare Cost Reporting, bankruptcy court reporting forms, preparation of balance sheets and income statements and bank account reconciliations. The Debtor's payroll is for 200 employees. It must be computed bi-weekly. My office spends 20 to 40 hours per month providing payroll and tax and accounting assistance to the Debtor which works out to approximately \$100 per hour or less for the services to be provided.
- 8. All compensation to be paid to me shall be subject to Court approval through the submission of fee applications and that such fee applications shall include an itemized list of time expended, identify the person expending the time and services provided pursuant to Rule 2016.

- 9. I will maintain time and expense records which will be submitted to the Court for review and approval as permitted pursuant to Rule 2016(d).
- 10. I request that fee applications be heard at 30 day intervals on the Court's regularly scheduled hearing dates. This will assist the Court, Debtor, U.S. Trustee and other interested parties in determining if I am being compensated inappropriately.
