The Court, having considered the Cash Collateral Motion and additional pleadings and arguments any evidence presented in connection therewith, the statements and representations of

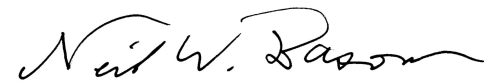
