## EXPEDITED MOTION TO SELL PROPERTY BY PUBLIC AUCTION FREE AND CLEAR OF LIENS, CLAIMS AND INTERESTS

The Motion of American Container, Inc., (the "Debtor"), to Sell Property Free and Clear of Liens, Claims and Interests respectfully represents as follows:

- On July 15, 2016, the Debtor filed a Voluntary Petition for Relief under Chapter
   of the United States Bankruptcy Code.
- 2. The Debtor has exercised its sound business judgment in determining that certain items of personal property should be sold, as they are no longer needed for the continued operation of the Debtor and do not contribute significant value to the business as a going concern. - 4. The sale is proposed to be made free and clear of all liens, claims and interests pursuant to Section 363(f) of the Bankruptcy Code, with such liens, claims and interests

attaching to the proceeds of sale. The Debtor believes that CM Sterling, LLC, holds the only valid, perfected security interest in the subject property.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Debtor respectfully requests this

Honorable Court to approve the proposed sale free and clear of liens, claims and interests,

authorize the Debtor to disburse the net proceeds of sale to CM Sterling, LLC, to the extent of its

allowed secured claim, and for such other relief as the Court may deem proper.
