CHAPTER 11

ORDER GRANTING PRELIMINARY HEARING AND SETTING FINAL HEARING
ON MOTION OF WORLD BUSINESS LENDERS, LLC,
TO ENJOIN DEBTOR'S USE OF CASH COLLATERAL

THIS CAUSE, coming on to be heard and being heard before the Honorable Laura T. Beyer, United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Western District of North Carolina, upon the Motion (I) To Enjoin Use Of Cash Collateral, (II) For Adequate Protection, (III) To Modify Stay and (IV) For Other Relief (the "Motion") (Docket No. 39) filed herein by World Business Lenders, LLC (hereinafter "Movant"); and

Whereupon, Movant appeared by counsel, William F. Kirk, the Debtor appeared by counsel, R. Keith Johnson, Donald Ray Thrower and Elizabeth Walser Thrower appeared by counsel, David R. Badger, and Linda Simpson, Bankruptcy Administrator, appeared; and

Whereas, counsel for Movant stated in open court Movant's withdrawal of its request for relief from the automatic stay but requested the Motion be heard with respect to enjoining the Debtor's use of cash collateral; and

It appearing to the Court that the matters before this Court have been properly served on all parties in interest as required by the Bankruptcy Rules and that each party has received adequate and timely notice of the hearing on this matte; and

The Court having heard the arguments and representations of counsels for the Movant and Debtor with respect to enjoining the Debtor's use of cash collateral, and for good cause appearing, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that the Motion is granted insofar as the hearing held the 7th day of December, 2016, shall be deemed a preliminary hearing and the Motion is continued and is hereby set for a final hearing on January 11, 2017, at 10:30 a.m. No further relief or action is ordered at this time. No further notice of the final hearing as set hereby shall be required.
