Comments re: 2 and 5, above

On December 9, 2013, the Debtor was informed that it's current bank, Citibank, refused to include the Debtor in Possession ("DIP") notation on the prepetition bank accounts as required in the Cash Management Motion. Therefore, on December 10, 2013, the Debtor arranged to open new bank accounts at City National Bank, an UST approved depository, as follows:

Concentration Account (General Account), #xxxxx6464

Payroll Account (Payroll wages and taxes are charged simultaneously when payroll is processed), #xxxxxx6472 and Credit Card Sales Account (Account utilized to process any credit card sales) xxxxxx6480.

Subsequently, in accordance with Court orders, the Debtor opened two additional accounts at City National:

Counsel Fee Escrow Account xxxxxx6367 and

Utilities Deposit Account xxxxxx6375.

Some of these accounts required on-line training which was delayed due to the holidays, illnesses and emergency surgery. Hence, some activity continued in the prepetition bank accounts in early January until the new DIP accounts at City National were fully operational and capable of accepting and receiving foreign and reverse wires as needed.

On or about April 1, 2014, the debtor opened an additional bank account at Wells Fargo xxxx16321.
