("ISDA") dated as of July 31, 2008 (the "ISDA Master Agreement"). U.S. Bank then froze a portion of the funds in a general deposit account ("Deposit Account") that GGPLP maintained at U.S. Bank. The following day U.S. Bank declared \$3,627,764.24 due and owing under the ISDA Master Agreement and withdrew and set off that amount from the Deposit Account. GGPLP and the Debtors reserve all rights in connection with the setoff and the withdrawal of funds from the Deposit Account at U.S. Bank.
