The Debtors do not appear to be within the scope of the Examiner's investigation, and Jenner & Block will not be representing the Debtors in any matters involving the Lehman entities.

- c. Jenner & Block has been retained to represent Adam Metz individually as a fact witness in a deposition noticed in *Center Partners, Ltd., et al. v. Urban Shopping Centers, L.P., et al*, No. 04-L-012194 (pending in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois, Law Division) (the "*Center Partners Case*"). GGP and certain of its affiliates are named as defendants in the *Center Partners Case* and are represented by separate counsel.

19. I do not believe that any of these current or former representations constitute a conflict with Jenner & Block's representation of the Debtors nor will likely create a conflict in the future.

20. The aforementioned matters are subject to the same restrictions Jenner & Block places on all such representations in the context of a chapter 11 debtor representation. Without obtaining appropriate waivers, if necessary, Jenner & Block will not represent the Debtors in a lawsuit, adversary proceeding or contested matter against any client. In addition, Jenner & Block will not represent any client on any matter involving the Debtors while retained as the Debtors' counsel in these cases.

21. While Jenner & Block has undertaken, and continues to undertake, extensive efforts to identify connections with the Debtors and other parties in interest, it is possible that connections with some parties in interest have not yet been identified. Should Jenner & Block, through its continuing efforts, learn of any new connections of the nature discussed herein, Jenner & Block will so advise the Court.
