4. The Debtor, NLRB and Longshoremen 2038 are hereby authorized to consummate the settlement detailed in the Motion and to execute and all documents necessary to effect same.

5. The NLRB acknowledges that the Claims listed above are the only pending claims against the Debtor or its estate related to the facts and circumstances giving rise to the Claims. The circumstances giving rise to the Claims are beyond the six month statute of limitations set forth in the National Labor Relations Act. Although the NLRB has no authority to waive any entity's/individual's right to file a charge under the Act, any future charges arising out of the circumstances giving rise to the Claims would be dismissed by the NLRB as untimely.
