**ORDER APPROVING SALE OF ESTATE'S INTEREST IN TRUCKS AND  
AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF LIENHOLDERS ON SUCH TRUCKS**

The Court has considered the Debtor in Possession's Motion for Order Approving Sale of Surplus Trucks and Authorizing the Payment of Lienholders on such Trucks. The Court finds that (i) the proposed sale is in the best interest of the estate and its creditors; (ii) adequate notice of the proposed sale and the hearing to consider the sale has been given to all creditors and parties-in-interest; and (iii) the proposed sale is a sound exercise of the Debtor in Possession's business judgment pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 363(b). Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Debtor in Possession is authorized to sell the estate's interest in the following Trucks:

2. The Debtor in Possession is authorized and directed to pay from the sale proceeds the lienholders in the "amount lien" described in this order.


3. The Debtor in Possession is authorized to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the sale conveying all right, title and interest in and to the Trucks to the Purchasers.
