payments so that these sureity bonds are maintained in favor of the states of Louisiana and Mississippi, and the utility companies. The Debtors may be required gaming tax and utility utility deposits in compliance with section 366 of the Bankruptcy Code and these amounts may be in addition to the cash disbursements itemized here.

(2) This estimate includes marketing expenses and the payment of up to \$67,500 per month to Foundation Gaming Group LLC pursuant to a consulting arrangement for marketing and other recommendations for the improvement of the Company's business.

(3) The Debtors' beginning and ending cash balance includes approximately \$6.7 million of cash (the "Gaming Facilities Cash") that the Debtors maintain at their gaming locations and bank accounts which is restricted by Gaming Regulations.
