A. Global Notes

1. Background

Magnetation LLC ("Mag LLC"), together with its wholly-owned subsidiaries¹ (collectively the "Debtors"), is an iron ore recovery and processing company that uses magnetic separation technology to recover iron material from fine and coarse tailings that were left behind from prior mining operations. The iron ore concentrate that is recovered is primarily used by the Debtors to produce iron ore pellets, which are sold to AK Steel Corporation pursuant to a long-term contract. The Debtors own three iron ore concentrate plants in Minnesota (one of which is currently idled) and an iron ore pellet processing plant in Indiana. Mag LLC is a joint venture formed by Magnetation, Inc. (50.1% owner) and AK Iron Resources, LLC (49.9% owner), a wholly-owned subsidiary of AK Steel Corporation.

2. Introduction

On May 5, 2015 (the "Commencement Date"), the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Minnesota (the "Chapter 11 Cases"). The Debtors continue to operate their businesses and manage their properties as debtors in possession pursuant to sections 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code. On May 12, 2015, the United States Trustee for the District of Minnesota appointed a statutory committee of unsecured creditors pursuant to section 1102(a)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code. Information contained herein may differ from the Debtors' bankruptcy court filings on the Commencement Date due to more accurate information becoming available.

3. Accounting Principles

The financial statements and supplemental information contained herein are preliminary and unaudited. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles ("GAAP"), other than as noted, as applicable to debtors in possession.

The preparation of the financial statements requires the Debtors' management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities as of the date set forth on the financial statements and income and expenses during the reporting period. In developing these estimates and assumptions, management used available evidence at the time of the financial statements. Because of the uncertainties associated with estimating these amounts and the timing and likelihood of possible outcomes, actual results could differ from the Debtors' estimates. Supplemental information contained herein is generally presented on a cash and/or invoiced basis.

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4. General Methodology

The Debtors prepared this Monthly Operating Report (the "MOR") relying primarily upon the information set forth in their books and records. In preparing the MOR, the Debtors used reasonable efforts to supplement the information set forth in their books and records with additional information concerning transactions that may not have been identified therein, to the extent necessary.

5. Past Performance

The financial position and results of operations contained herein are not necessarily indicative of future results that may be expected for any other period or for the full year and, as a result, may not reflect the consolidated financial position and results of operations of the Debtors in the future. The Debtors are still ramping up the production capabilities at one of their iron ore concentrate plants (Plant 4), which began operations in December 2014 and at their pellet plant in Reynolds, Indiana, which began producing pellets in September 2014. It is expected that as the production capabilities of these plants increase, the cost per ton to operate these facilities will decrease, all else being equal.

6. Carrying Value of the Assets

Unless otherwise indicated, the values for assets contained in the MOR are book values as of the reporting period. Amounts ultimately realized from the disposition of the Debtors' assets may vary materially from their book value. The Debtors reserve the right to amend or adjust the value of each asset or liability set forth herein.

7. Postpetition Liabilities

Although payment of prepetition claims generally is not permitted under the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Court granted the Debtors the authority to pay certain prepetition claims in designated categories and subject to certain terms and conditions. This relief generally was designed to preserve the value of the Debtors' businesses and assets. To the extent such claims have been categorized in "Postpetition Liabilities" herein, the Debtors reserve the right to not pay those amounts if they believe the payment not to be in the best interests of the Debtors' estates. The Debtors have paid and continue to pay undisputed postpetition obligations incurred in the ordinary course of business.

8. Prepetition Liabilities

As a result of commencing the Chapter 11 Cases, the payment of prepetition indebtedness is subject to compromise or other treatment under a chapter 11 plan. Generally, actions to enforce or otherwise effect payment of prepetition liabilities are stayed.

Following a hearing on May 7, 2015, the Bankruptcy Court approved the Debtors' motion to set deadlines for filing proofs of claim. Non-governmental parties were required to submit proofs of claim no later than July 22, 2015 (extended from the original deadline of July 15, 2015). Governmental units were required to submit proofs of claim no later than November 9, 2015 (extended from the original deadline of November 2, 2015).

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Additionally, the Bankruptcy Court entered an order on July 16, 2015, approving the Debtors' motion to set procedures for the assertion, resolution and allowance of claims asserted pursuant to section 503(b)(9) of the Bankruptcy Code. Creditors were required to file such claims by September 1, 2015 in accordance with these procedures. The Debtors were required to issue a report expressing their view on the validity of these claims by October 16, 2015. On October 16, 2015, the Debtors filed their Section 503(b)(9) Report and Notice of Objection Procedures [ECF No. 388].

9. Reservation of Rights

Given the complexity of the Debtors' businesses, inadvertent errors or omissions may have occurred in the preparation of this MOR. Accordingly, the Debtors hereby reserve all rights to dispute the validity, status or enforceability of any claim amounts, representations or other statements in the MOR and reserve the right to amend or supplement this MOR, if necessary.

Nothing contained in this MOR shall constitute a waiver of the Debtors' rights or an admission with respect to the Chapter 11 Cases, including with respect to any issues regarding the Debtors' ownership interests, substantive consolidation, equitable subordination, defenses and/or causes of action arising under chapter 5 of the Bankruptcy Code and other applicable non-bankruptcy law.

B. Notes to Form 2B

The cash balances shown on Form 2B of this MOR represent the balances recorded in the Debtors' general ledger, which are typically lower than the amounts in the Debtors' bank accounts due to outstanding disbursements (checks and ACH's).

The proceeds from the Debtors' Debtor-in-Possession Financing Facility (the "DIP Financing Facility") are initially deposited into the DIP Funding Account and the Debtors make periodic requests to transfer funds from the DIP Funding Account to the DIP Operating Account. On June 22, 2015, the DIP lenders provided \$12.5 million pursuant to the "Second NM Funding" set forth in the DIP Financing Facility, of which \$12.4 million was transferred into the DIP Funding Account (net of \$.1 million in fees). The Cash Flow Summary on Form 2B only reflects third-party transactions into and out of DIP Funding Account and DIP Operating Account (but not between such accounts), and also excludes the Debtors' escrow accounts.

The Debtors have two escrow accounts, which together hold approximately \$23.6 million of cash. Approximately \$23.4 million relates to the deposit account that holds the equivalent of one interest payment in respect of the prepetition notes. A second account holds approximately \$0.2 million and was set up pursuant to the DIP Financing Facility to hold the funds for the Prepetition Secured Note Trustee Escrow Account. In accordance with the DIP Financing Facility, approximately \$1.1 million of the funds in Prepetition Secured Note Trustee Escrow Account was transferred to the DIP Funding Account on August 12, 2015.

Prior to the Commencement Date, in an effort to enhance the liquidity of the Debtors, AK Steel Corporation (the Debtors' largest customer) paid the Debtors contemporaneously with the Debtors'

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shipment of iron ore pellets to AK Steel Corporation. Starting in the week after the Commencement Date, the payment terms reverted back to the original contract term of 45 days.

C. Notes to Form 2C

The Debtors have undertaken a review of their liabilities in order to segregate prepetition and postpetition liabilities. The deadline for filing proofs of claim was July 22, 2015 for non-governmental entities. It is likely that the results of the claims reconciliation process, along with subsequent processing and analysis of invoices, will result in changes to the ultimate amount of prepetition liabilities.

On May 7, 2015, the Debtors received the initial funding of \$55.0 million (including the term roll-up of approximately \$3.8 million) under the DIP Financing Facility. After the funding of the Prepetition Secured Note Trustee Escrow Account as well as professional fees and financing fees, the remaining amount of \$44.2 million was deposited with the Debtors. On June 22, 2015, the Debtors borrowed the remaining \$12.5 million (net of \$.1 million in fees) under its DIP Financing Facility. In addition, \$67.0 million of the prepetition notes were rolled up into the balance of the DIP Financing Facility on July 7, 2015.

The Debtors' prepetition secured debt includes the prepetition notes (excluding the portion rolled up under the DIP Financing Facility), the prepetition revolver and various capital leases.

The reduction in the prepetition unsecured debt from the Commencement Date to November 30, 2015 is primarily a result of settlement of claims pursuant to the critical vendor motion, the payments of accrued wages and benefits pursuant to the employee wages and benefits motion, the payments of prepetition royalty and production tax obligations, the satisfaction of claims via the drawing down on letters of credit and adjustment to accruals.

D. Notes to Form 2D

The Debtors did not conduct a full month-end closing as of the Commencement Date; however, the Debtors did review their results of operations and made adjustments that they believe segregate the prepetition results of operations from the postpetition results of operations. These adjustments include:

- Accrue interest on all prepetition interest-bearing debt through May 4, 2015;
- Include in the prepetition results of operations the sales and cost of sales for product shipped between May 1, 2015 and May 4, 2015;
- Include in the prepetition results of operations 4/31 (12.9%) of the period costs for May 2015;
- Include in the prepetition results of operations the prepetition professional fees that were capitalized on the balance sheet as potential transaction costs; and
- Include in the prepetition results of operations certain adjustments to revise the valuation of inventory costs for inventory produced prepetition.

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The Debtors' income statement includes the accrual of interest related to its prepetition notes from the Commencement Date forward. The Restructuring Support Agreement by and among Mag LLC and certain holders of the prepetition notes, and consented to by Magnetation, Inc., provides for the holders of prepetition notes to receive postpetition interest to the extent they are entitled. The Debtors believe that the aggregate value of the collateral would need to exceed the amount of the prepetition notes in order for postpetition interest to be allowed. The Debtors have indicated in previous filings with the Bankruptcy Court that they believe the aggregate amount of the prepetition notes substantially exceeds the aggregate value of the collateral.

The Debtors have recognized reorganization expense for professional fees incurred in November 2015 and the payment of a \$1.3 million to the DIP Lenders in connection with a waiver of certain reporting covenants under the DIP Financing Facility and an amendment of the DIP Financing Facility to extend certain case milestones set forth therein.

E. Notes to Form 2E

The Debtors fund federal and Minnesota state income taxes withheld from employees' payroll checks contemporaneous with the funding of the Debtors' payroll. As of November 30, 2015, the Debtors did not have any withheld income taxes from employees' payroll checks that were not remitted (other than for the state of Indiana).

The accounts receivable aging classifies the Debtors' accounts receivables by the number of days the invoice is past due. The Debtors ship pellets to AK Steel on 45-day terms.

The postpetition accounts payable aging classifies the Debtors' accounts payable invoices by the number of days the invoice is past due. Accrued purchases and other accruals are classified in the under 30 days past due bucket.

Mag LLC is organized as a limited liability company and does not pay corporate income tax.

The Debtors pay a management service fee to Magnetation, Inc. for the costs of Magnetation, Inc. employees who render service to the Debtors and other expenses of Magnetation, Inc. that benefit the Debtors. All the officers of the Debtors are employees of Magnetation, Inc.² and, therefore, their compensation is included in the fees paid under the management services agreement between Mag LLC and Magnetation, Inc.

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² Magnetation, Inc. also employs managers and support staff that provide services to Mag LLC, in addition to the officers.

Please provide a brief description of any significant business and legal actions taken by the debtor, its creditors, or the court during the reporting period, any unusual or non-recurring accounting transactions that are reported in the financial statements, and any significant changes in the financial condition of the debtor which have occurred subsequent to the report date.

The Debtors¹ filed for bankruptcy protection under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code on May 5, 2015. On May 7, 2015, the Bankruptcy Court approved several motions, including customary early case motions that, among other things, (1) allowed the Debtors to pay prepetition wages and benefits for its workforce, (2) prohibited utilities from discontinuing service and authorized the Debtors to provide adequate assurance deposits, (3) allowed the Debtors to maintain their existing cash management system, (4) authorized the Debtors to pay prepetition obligations to certain critical vendors and shippers, and (5) authorized the Debtors to enter into a post-petition Debtor-in-Possession ("DIP") financing facility on an interim basis.

On June 10, 2015, the Bankruptcy Court (i) approved the Debtors' retention of FTI Consulting, Inc. and the designation of Michael J. Talarico as Chief Restructuring Officer and (ii) authorized the Debtors to enter into the DIP financing facility on a final basis.

On July 14, 2015, the Bankruptcy Court approved the Restructuring Support Agreement (the "RSA").

On August 3, 2015, the Debtors filed their Plan of Reorganization as required under the milestones set forth in the DIP financing facility.

On August 12, 2015, approximately \$1.1 million of funds held in the Prepetition Secured Note Trustee Escrow Account were transferred into the DIP Funding Account, pursuant to the terms of the DIP financing facility.

On September 8, 2015, the Debtors filed a motion (under seal) seeking authorization to assume their iron ore offtake agreement with AK Steel Corporation and, on October 8, 2015, AK Steel Corporation submitted an objection to the assumption of the iron ore offtake agreement. As noted below, the Bankruptcy Court held a preliminary hearing on the motion on October 13, 2015.

On October 16, 2015, the Debtors filed their Section 503(b)(9) Report and Notice of Objection Procedures [ECF No. 388].

A telephonic omnibus hearing was held on November 10, 2015. The matters heard at the omnibus hearing included:

- 1. Fee applications for several of the professionals retained by the Bankruptcy Court; and
- 2. Request by several alleged mechanics' liens claimants for limited relief from the Automatic Stay to preserve their rights to proceed with litigation against land owners where the Debtors' assets are located.

The Bankruptcy Court granted the motions presented at the November 10, 2015 omnibus hearing.

On November 13, 2015, the Debtors paid \$1.3 million to the DIP Lenders in exchange for a waiver of certain reporting covenants under the DIP Financing Facility and an amendment of the DIP Financing Facility to extend certain case milestones set forth therein.

On November 18, 2015, the Debtors issued a WARN notice with respect to its concentrate plant in Bovey, Minnesota.

On November 23, 2015, the Debtors filed their pre-hearing brief in support of their motion to assume their iron ore offtake agreement with AK Steel. The Bankruptcy Court held a final hearing on the motion to assume on December 2-4, 2015.

On November 25, 2015, the Debtors filed an amended Schedule G of unexpired executory contracts.

As of November 30, 2015, there were no Events of Default under the DIP financing facility.


