- 3. Attached as Exhibit A is a summary of temporary and full-time professionals engaged by APS in connection with this case during the Staffing Period, along with their respective functions. In addition to the officer roles of James Bonsall, various professionals at APS are engaged in cash management, development of business plan(s), assistance with managing the multiple lender groups in the case, preparation of schedules and reports for the Court, and assistance with the claims process.
- 4. During this Staffing Period, the following professionals were added to the engagement to assist with data preservation issues and the cure process associated with the assumption and assignment of executory contracts, Sean Renshaw and Anne Hollingsworth. In addition, the following professionals that had performed duties during various monthly periods prior to March provided no services during the March, 2009 staffing period: John Franks, Robert Rakowski and Julia Mysinger.
- 5. APS may determine, from time to time, to augment its professional staff with independent contractors (each an "Independent Contractor") in these chapter 11 cases. APS' standard practice is to charge for an Independent Contractor's services at the APS rate for a professional of comparable skill and experience, which rate typically exceeds the compensation

provided by APS to such Independent Contractor. APS did not bill time for the use of Independent Contractors.
