In addition to any rights set forth in the Plan, the Debtors reserve the right to, among other things assert that any such lease is expired or any such contract is executed.

4. Storage Agreement made September 12, 2008 by and between Federal Record Storage Company and Neumann Homes, Inc.
5. Agreement for Construction of Potable Water Improvements, dated October 4, 2004, between Neumann Homes, Inc. and the Village of Antioch; provided that allowed cure claims, if any, with respect thereto shall be satisfied from tap fees in accordance with paragraph 1(f) of that certain Stipulation and Agreed Order Regarding Village of Antioch’s Motion for Relief From Stay and the Village of Antioch’s Supplemental Motion for Relief From Stay, dated July 23, 2008 (Docket No. 1103).
