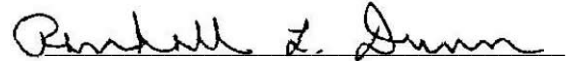

ORDER AUTHORIZING CONTINUED
USE OF CASH COLLATERAL AND
GRANTING ADEQUATE PROTECTION

This matter comes before the Court upon the continued motion (the "Motion") of Peter DeHaan Holsteins, LLC (the "Debtor") for an order authorizing continued use of cash collateral ("Cash Collateral"). Due and adequate notice under the circumstances having been given, and the Court having heard the representations and argument of counsel, and being fully advised of the premises thereof,

NOW THEREFORE, THE COURT FINDS AS FOLLOWS:

A. Commencement of Case. On June 29, 2012 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief with this Court, commencing a case (the "Chapter 11 Case") under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code"). Since the Petition Date, the Debtor has continued to manage and

1 operate its property and business as debtor in possession pursuant to sections 1107
2 and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code.

3 B. Jurisdiction and Venue. This Court has jurisdiction over this proceeding
4 and the parties and properties affected hereby pursuant to 28 USC §§ 157(b) and 1334
5 and this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 USC § 157(b)(2). Venue for proceeding on
6 the Motion is proper in this Court pursuant to 28 USC § 1409.

7 C. No Creditors' Committee. To date, the United States Trustee has not
8 appointed a committee pursuant to section 1102(a) of the Bankruptcy Code.

9 D. Prepetition Indebtedness and Security Therefore. The Debtor's secured
10 lender is Farm Credit. As of the Petition Date, the amounts claimed by Farm Credit
11 were approximately \$6.54 million. The amounts claimed by Farm Credit as of the
12 Petition Date consist of and include the following loan obligations:

14	Loan 142:	\$3,319,191.16
15	Loan 246:	\$ 974,677.41
16	Loan 242:	<u>\$ 121,441.29</u>
17	Total:	\$6,540,943.30

18 Farm Credit asserts that Farm Credit's claims against the Debtor are secured by valid,
19 enforceable, and properly perfected first priority security interests in the majority of the
20 Debtor's assets, and in all cash and noncash proceeds of such property.

21 E. Necessity of Use of Cash Collateral. The Debtor's sole source of revenue
22 is cash, including Cash Collateral, and it is necessary for the Debtor to pay operating
23 expenses pursuant to cash collateral orders and budgets during this Chapter 11 case.
24 Use of Cash Collateral to pay expenses as set forth in the budget attached hereto as
25 Exhibit 1 (the "Budget") is necessary to avoid immediate and irreparable harm to the
26 estate.

1 F. Cause. Entry of this Order will minimize disruption of the Debtor's
2 business as a going concern, preserve the value of the Debtor's assets, and is in the
3 best interests of the Debtor, its creditors, and its estate.

4 G. Notice. Notice of the relief requested in the Motion has previously been
5 given to (a) the Office of the United States Trustee, (b) Farm Credit, (c) the creditors
6 holding the 20 largest unsecured claims against the Debtor, (d) all known secured
7 creditors and (e) all parties requesting special notice pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 2002.
8 Sufficient and adequate notice of the hearing and the relief requested in the Motion has
9 been given pursuant to all applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code and the
10 Bankruptcy Rules, including, without limitation, Section 102(1) of the Bankruptcy Code
11 and Bankruptcy Rules 2002 and 4001.

12 **NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

13 1. The Debtor is authorized to use Cash Collateral through the Termination
14 Date (as defined below), solely in accordance with the terms of this Order to pay costs
15 and expenses incurred by the Debtor in the ordinary course of its business, consistent
16 with the Budget.

17 2. The Debtor's authority to use Cash Collateral is limited to the amounts set
18 forth in the Budget and such sums as may be required to satisfy utility deposits
19 provided; however, that the Debtor may make expenditures in excess of said sums so
20 long as any variance shall not exceed 10% of the cumulative expenses as set forth in
21 the Budget. The Debtor may exceed such variances only with the prior written consent
22 of Farm Credit or order of this Court. Amounts budgeted for legal and accounting fees
23 may be deposited in trust with Debtor's counsel, with such funds to be held pending
24 application to and approval by the Court.

25 3. The Debtor shall not borrow money from any person or entity on a
26 secured basis without first obtaining authority from the Court.

1 4. The Debtor's authority to use Cash Collateral, without further order of the
2 Court issued after notice and hearing or the written consent of Farm Credit, shall
3 automatically expire upon the earlier of (a) September 30, 2013, or (b) regardless of
4 whether the Debtor has expended the entire amount set forth in the Budget, the material
5 breach by the Debtor of any provision of this Order (such failure being an "Event of
6 Default"), which failure is not remedied within ten business days after delivery of notice
7 of such failure by Farm Credit to the Debtor (the earlier of such dates, the "Termination
8 Date"). Upon the Termination Date, the Debtor's authority to use or spend any further
9 Cash Collateral shall automatically terminate unless and until the Debtor obtains the
10 written consent of Farm Credit or a further order of this Court authorizing such use,
11 issued after notice and an opportunity for a hearing; provided, however, that
12 notwithstanding the occurrence of the Termination Date, the Debtor shall be authorized
13 to use Cash Collateral to pay those budgeted amounts that have been incurred prior to
14 the Termination Date.

15 5. As adequate protection for any Cash Collateral used by the Debtor, Farm
16 Credit is hereby granted, pursuant to sections 361(1) and 363(e) of the Bankruptcy
17 Code, a perfected lien or liens (the "Farm Credit Replacement Liens") to secure an
18 amount up to the allowed amount of Farm Credit's prepetition secured claim against the
19 Debtor, equal to the extent of any diminution in value of Farm Credit's prepetition
20 collateral (the "Prepetition Collateral") by reason of the use of Cash Collateral
21 authorized herein. The Farm Credit Replacement Liens shall not improve Farm Credit's
22 position or increase the amount of Farm Credit's allowed prepetition secured claim. The
23 Farm Credit Replacement Liens shall attach to all property and assets of the Debtor and
24 its estate of the same kind or nature as the Prepetition Collateral, including but not
25 limited to milk and livestock, whether now owned or hereinafter acquired by the Debtor,
26 and all products, proceeds, rents, issues or profits thereof; provided, however, the Farm

1 Credit Replacement Liens shall not attach to property recoverable or recovered through
2 the exercise of the powers granted under sections 506(c), 544, 545, 547, 548, 549, and
3 550 of the Bankruptcy Code. These security interests are granted to Farm Credit for the
4 sole purpose of providing adequate protection to Farm Credit to protect its allowed
5 secured claim on the Petition Date and are not intended, nor shall they be deemed, to
6 improve the collateral position of Farm Credit as of the Petition Date.

7 6. The Farm Credit Replacement Liens shall be in addition to all other
8 security interests and liens securing Farm Credit's allowed secured claim in existence
9 on the Petition Date. Additionally, nothing in this Order shall abridge or limit Farm
10 Credit's security interest in proceeds, products, or profits to the extent provided under
11 Section 552 of the Bankruptcy Code.

12 7. The Replacement Liens granted by this Order shall be deemed perfected
13 and enforceable by operation of law upon execution and entry of this Order by the Court
14 without regard to whether such security interests and liens are perfected under
15 applicable non-Bankruptcy law.

16 8. In the event of the occurrence of an Event of Default, and at all times
17 thereafter, Farm Credit may seek relief from the Court on ten business days written
18 notice to the Debtor to, among other things, (a) terminate forthwith the Debtor's use of
19 all or any portion of the Cash Collateral and (b) terminate the automatic stay imposed by
20 Section 362(a) of the Bankruptcy Code for the purpose of exercising its rights under its
21 loan agreement or applicable state law. The Debtor reserves all of its rights to oppose
22 such application.

23 9. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to (a) prejudice a right of any
24 party in interest (including the Debtor) to contest the validity, priority, or extent of the
25 liens or security interests of any party in any Prepetition Collateral or the proceeds
26 thereof; (b) convert any prepetition obligations into post-petition obligations; (c) require

1 payment of any obligations on confirmation of a plan of reorganization; (d) alter,
2 improve, limit, or impair the rights, if any, of parties claiming to have rights of
3 reclamation or statutory lien rights against the Debtor or its assets; or (e) enhance the
4 secured position of any creditor as of the Petition Date

5 10. The Debtor's authority to sell "cull cattle" and use the proceeds of such
6 sales in the operation of the Debtor's business shall be limited to the aggregate
7 amounts shown in the Budget. Amounts, if any, received from sales of cull cattle in
8 excess of the aggregate budgeted amounts shall be impressed with liens, deposited in
9 a segregated Debtor in Possession account and held pending further order of the Court.

10 11. For the period from July 15, 2013 through September 30, 2013, the Debtor
11 shall provide Farm Credit (and any other lien creditor who requests a copy of such
12 report) with a monthly reconciliation report which report will compare actual cash
13 receipts and disbursements to the budgeted amounts. The Debtor shall provide such
14 reports to Farm Credit (and any other party who requests a copy of such report) no later
15 than the 15th day of each month for the prior month. Debtor shall also provide Farm
16 Credit (and any other party who requests a copy) with Debtor's CPA prepared quarterly
17 reports.

18 12. The Debtor's authority to use cash collateral may be extended beyond the
19 amounts in the Budget or the Budget period by mutual agreement of the Debtor and
20 Farm Credit or by order of the Court. In the event of such agreement, the Debtor may
21 submit a further order allowing the use of Cash Collateral on substantially similar terms
22 without an additional motion or hearing, provided the terms of any future proposed order
23 are first served on the United States Trustee, the top twenty Unsecured Creditors (or
24 the Unsecured Creditor's Committee if one is appointed) and anyone requesting special
25 notice, within 3 business days prior to its submission to the court with an opportunity to
26 object and request a hearing.

1 13. This Order, and each of its terms, shall be effective immediately upon
2 entry by the Court and the automatic stay of judgment provisions of Bankruptcy Rule
3 8017(a) shall not apply.

4 14. Nothing herein shall preclude any creditor or any party in interest from
5 requesting additional relief from the Court.
