The Debtors believe this resolves the objection.
4.	443	Northwest Evaluation Association	<p>The cure amount set forth on the Contract/Lease Assumption Schedule is not correct.</p> <p>The Debtors have not provided adequate assurance of future performance.</p> <p>The Debtors failed to provide timely notice of the assumption.</p>	<b>Resolved.</b> Northwest Evaluation Association has withdrawn its objection, as reflected in the agenda. [Docket No. 523]. The amended Contract/Lease Assumption Schedule will be revised to reflect an agreed cure amount equal to \$54,185.41, which is consistent with the Debtors' books and records.

Counsel to Rachel Ray Digital, LLC has indicated the objection will be withdrawn.
7.	450	Disney Licensed Publishing	The Contract/Lease Assumption Schedule does not include all of the contracts being assumed by the Debtors under the Plan, and the cure amount listed thereon is not correct.	<b>In progress.</b> This is not a confirmation objection, <i>per se</i> , but, rather, relates to the consolidated listing of contracts, and a dispute about the \$142,650.34 aggregate cure amount set forth on the Contract/Lease Assumption Schedule. The Debtors are reviewing their books and records and working with counsel for Disney in good faith to resolve the objection consensually prior to the Confirmation Hearing and will update the Court with respect to the status of same at that time.
