**STIPULATED ORDER EXTENDING AUTHORIZATION
FOR USE OF CASH COLLATERAL THROUGH JUNE
30, 2026, AND GRANTING ADEQUATE PROTECTION**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on the stipulation of the undersigned parties to extend the authority granted for its *Third Motion for an Order Approving Use of Cash Collateral and Granting Adequate Protection for Cash Collateral Period from March 1, 2026, through and including May 31, 2026 and Motion for Approval of Adequate Protection Agreement with First Citizens Bank & Trust Company* (the “Motion”), filed on February 9, 2026 (Docket No. 121).

WHEREFORE, being sufficiently advised, the Court FINDS:

1. An Amended Stipulated Order Authorizing Use of Cash Collateral through May 31, 2026, and Granting Adequate Protection (the “Amended Stipulated Order”) was entered on April 1, 2026 (Docket No. 150).

2. The Amended Order authorized the use of cash collateral through May 31, 2026.
3. Debtor's confirmation hearing is set on June 17, 2026.
4. The parties stipulate that the use of cash collateral should be extended through June 30, 2026, to cover the period including the confirmation hearing. It is anticipated by Debtor that approval will not be necessary beyond the end of June, 2026.

It is therefore ORDERED that:

- A. Debtor's authority to use cash collateral, as set forth in the Amended Stipulated Order (Docket No. 150) is hereby extended to June 30, 2026, including adequate protection as set forth in said order;
- B. Debtor's approved cash collateral budget for May shall be its cash collateral budget for June;
- C. Debtor shall continue making adequate protection payments to Kapitus and First Citizens as set forth in the Amended Order; and
- D. All other conditions and requirements for the use of cash collateral set forth in the Amended Order remain in effect.
