IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. The Motion is granted;
- 2. The Stipulation attached as Exhibit 1 to the Motion is approved;
- 3. The Debtor is authorized to use cash collateral through January 31, 2018, in the amounts set forth in the Cash Budget Thru January 2018 dated 8/29/17 (the "Budget") which is attached as Exhibit "1" to the Stipulation;
- 4. Granting a replacement lien to Cumming as adequate protection to the same validity, priority and extent as existed in its favor on the Petition Date;
- 5. Authorizing the Debtor to continue to deposit in a segregated debtor-in-possession bank account \$10,000.00 per month each month. The Debtor commenced making deposits in March 2017, and the deposits shall be included in the cash collateral that is subject to the replacement lien in favor of Cumming. No payments are to be made to Cumming until its claims are allowed by the Court and the Court enters an order authorizing distribution of the funds; and
