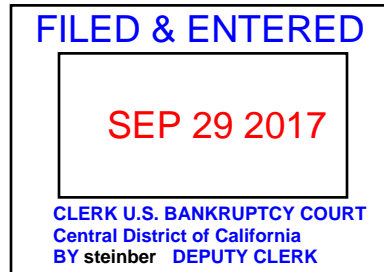

23 The hearing on the *DEBTOR'S MOTION FOR ORDER APPROVING FIRST STIPULATION*  
24 *WITH CUMMING CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, INC., dba CUMMING CORPORATION*  
25 *FOR USE OF CASH COLLATERAL; MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES AND*  
26 *DECLARATION OF CHRISTOPHER CLARKE IN SUPPORT THEREOF* [ECF DOCKET NO. 147  
27 (the "Motion") came on for hearing before the undersigned United States Bankruptcy Judge on  
28 September 27, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. The Court issued a tentative ruling to grant the Motion with

1 appearances optional. Pamela J. Zylstra, Esq. of Pamela Jan Zylstra A Professional Corporation as  
2 counsel on behalf of CLARKE PROJECT SOLUTIONS, INC., a California corporation, fka  
3 CUMMING CLARKE, the Debtor and Debtor-in-Possession, submitted on the tentative ruling.

4 Based on the Motion, the Declaration of Christopher Clarke in support thereof, the notice  
5 given of the hearing, the *DECLARATION OF PAMELA J. ZYLSTRA RE: RECEIPT OF NO*  
6 *OPPOSITION TO DEBTOR'S MOTION FOR ORDER APPROVING FIRST STIPULATION WITH*  
7 *CUMMING CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT, INC., dba CUMMING CORPORATION FOR USE*  
8 *OF CASH COLLATERAL* [ECF Docket No. 152], the Court having issued a tentative ruling to grant  
9 the Motion with appearances option, and good cause appearing,

10 IT IS ORDERED:

- 11 1. The Motion is granted;
- 12 2. The Stipulation attached as Exhibit 1 to the Motion is approved;
- 13 3. The Debtor is authorized to use cash collateral through January 31, 2018, in the  
14 amounts set forth in the Cash Budget Thru January 2018 dated 8/29/17 (the "Budget") which is  
15 attached as Exhibit "1" to the Stipulation;
- 16 4. Granting a replacement lien to Cumming as adequate protection to the same validity,  
17 priority and extent as existed in its favor on the Petition Date;
- 18 5. Authorizing the Debtor to continue to deposit in a segregated debtor-in-possession  
19 bank account \$10,000.00 per month each month. The Debtor commenced making deposits in  
20 March 2017, and the deposits shall be included in the cash collateral that is subject to the  
21 replacement lien in favor of Cumming. No payments are to be made to Cumming until its claims are  
22 allowed by the Court and the Court enters an order authorizing distribution of the funds; and
