Harrington LLP ("Greenfield Sullivan"), to commence the aforementioned Chapter 11 case, and to do all things, and to prepare, sign and file all papers or documents necessary or proper to the commencement of said Chapter 11 case; Greenfield Sullivan is authorized to take such actions in the bankruptcy case which Greenfield Sullivan, in its discretion, concludes are necessary to Greenfield Sullivan's and/or the Corporation's fulfillment of its fiduciary obligations in the bankruptcy case.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Corporate Resolution and its terms hereunder shall remain in effect unless otherwise agreed upon or amended by a duly-appointed Board of Directors.
