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TENTH REPORT OF THE PATIENT CARE OMBUDSMAN

Senior Advocacy Services is the designated Long-Term Care (LTC) Ombudsman Program for Sonoma County and is the local representative of the Office of the State LTC Ombudsman. As mandated by the federal Older Americans Act (42 U.S.C. 3058g), LTC Ombudsman representatives identify, investigate and resolve complaints that are made by, or on behalf of residents of LTC facilities that relate to action, inaction or decisions that may adversely affect the health, safety, welfare or rights of residents.

Sonoma Serenity Home is located at 17575 Carriger Road, Sonoma California. The California Department of Social Services, Community Care Licensing (CCL), licensed this facility as a Residential Care Facility for the Elderly (RCFE). RCFEs provide 24-hour care and supervision to seniors, including housing, meals, personal care, social activities, and coordination of medical appointments, to people who have physical, cognitive, or behavioral conditions that prevent them from living alone. Kathy Baldassari is the local Ombudsman representative assigned to this facility.

Based upon the events reported the Patient Care Ombudsman's second report to the court dated July 7, 2017, CCL obtained a Temporary Suspension Order (TSO) on Friday, July 7, 2017. This TSO

necessitated that all residents leave the facility and relocate to other facilities. This TSO also removed the ability of the facility to legally have any new residents in the home receiving care. Since that date, no residents have been in care at the facility. The facility no longer appears on CCL's website listing of licensed RCFEs.

As no residents are in care, the Patient Care Ombudsman has no recommendations for the court.
