NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Church file a petition for reorganization under Chapter 11, Title 11 U.S.C.;

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Church retain the law firm of Arrington, Oduola-Owoo & Mason as its counsel to prepare and file such documents as are necessary to initiate such Chapter 11 case and represent the Church in such Chapter 11 case, and the Church is authorized to pay Arrington, Oduola-Owoo & Mason a retainer of \$7,539.00, that includes a \$1,039 filing fee, and to pay such further and additional legal fees and expenses as may be approved;

FURTHER RESOLVED that Joseph A. Roseborough, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Church, is hereby authorized to execute and deliver all such documents and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to effectuate the foregoing resolutions and to otherwise, as may be required, act as an agent and representative of the Church.


