ARTICLE I. Georgia Code

Petitioner, Kuhusa Wanzu, the mailing address being, 1466 Avon Avenue, Atlanta, Georgia, is acting as incorporator for the corporation to be formed under the provisions of the Georgia Code, Title 22, Part 1, the Georgia Business Corporation Code.

ARTICLE II. Name

The name of the proposed corporation is LIFE ESSENTIAL-RAFIKI, INC.

ARTICLE III. Duration

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV. Office and Registered Agent

The initial registered agent is Kuhusa Wanzu and the initial registered office is located at 1466 Avon Avenue, Atlanta, Georgia.

ARTICLE VI. Profit

The corporation shall be organized for pecuniary gain or profit and shall have capital stock and shareholders.

ARTICLE VII. Purpose

The corporation shall be organized and operated for the purpose of operating a nature food store for profit to the general public in every proper and legitimate manner according to usage and customs of business.

ARTICLE VIII. Capitalization

Section 1.

The corporation shall initially issue and sell one million (1,000,000) shares of common stock at par value of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per share. The corporation shall not commence business until it shall have received not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) in payment for the insurance of shares in stock.

Section 2.

Each shareholder holding a certificate of ownership of a share has the right to one vote per share in all matters pertaining to policy and control of the operation.

Section 3.

Certificates of stock shall be issued in the manner prescribed by law to each stockholder, showing the number of shares to which he is entitled. Each certificate shall be signed by the President and Treasurer or Secretary and shall have the corporation affixed thereto. When fully paid, all stock shall be nonassessable.

Section 2.

In furtherance and not in limitation of the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Georgia, the Board of this Corporation is expressly authorized and empowered to make, alter or repeal the bylaws of this corporation (other than bylaws providing by their terms for amendment or repeal only with the approval of the stockholders). ARTICLE X. Dividends

Any and all dividends may be paid in additional and full and fractional reinvested shares of the corporation at net asset value under such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors. In such event there may be extended to the stockholders entitled to receive such dividend of a portion thereof in cash such right to be exercised only within the time and under such conditions as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors.

Section 4.

The shareholders shall have any preemptive rights to buy any unissued shares of the corporation.

Such right of purchase shall not be considered an option or warrant to purchase shares of the corporation and shall be exercised only within the time and under such conditions as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XI. Amendment

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in the Certificates of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter provided by statute and the rights granted to stockholders herein are granted subject to the reservation.

ARTICLE XII. Titles

The titles to the foregoing articles are solely for identification and shall neither be considered as a part of the article nor used to interpret the meaning thereof.
