October 24, 2018


William Whited, Oklahoma State Long-Term Care Ombudsman, having been appointed Patient Care Ombudsman in this case on May 24, 2018, submits his second report to the Court pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 333.

The patient care Ombudsman continues to monitor care to residents in Meeker Nursing home. Multiple visits have been made by designated Ombudsman staff. During the visits by the designees the Ombudsman noted the following:

1. The facility was meeting the care needs of the residents during each visit;
2. The facility has met the minimum staffing ratios set forth in the Oklahoma Nursing Home Care Act;
3. All supplies and food stocks have been adequate during each visit;
4. No complaints relating to care have been received by the Office of the State Long-Term Care Ombudsman during this reporting period, and
5. A review of survey and complaint information from the Oklahoma State

Department of Health indicates no substantiated complaints or deficiencies have been issued since the appointment of the patient care Ombudsman.
