Supplement to Response to Question 12: Does the debtor own or have possession of any real property or personal property that needs immediate attention?

The property.

The Solvay Coke & Gas site is located at 311 East Greenfield Avenue in Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin. It covers approximately 46 acres in a primarily industrial and commercial area north of the Kinnickinnic River and west of the Lincoln Memorial Harbor. The site is bordered to the north by East Greenfield Avenue, to the northeast by railroad tracks and a coal storage area, to the east and south by the Kinnickinnic River, and to the west by more railroad tracks. This site is not on the National Priorities List. It is a federal Superfund Alternative Site (SAS)

Environmental issues.

The various industrial activities occurred on different lots on the property maybe as early as 1866. A manufactured coke and gas facility located on the northern portion was operated by various entities until approximately 1983. The southernmost triangular tip of the property was occupied by several leather tannery companies starting in about 1884. Wisconsin Wrecking operated a scrap and salvage operation on the northern portion until January 2003.

In October 2001, U.S. EPA, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR), and the city of Milwaukee conducted a site reconnaissance to evaluate site conditions to determine potential areas of contamination for sampling. In December 2001, U.S. EPA conducted a multimedia sampling event at the site to screen for possible contaminants and to identify actual or potential threats to human health and the environment. U.S. EPA issued a Site Assessment Report, dated May 1, 2002, that summarized site conditions, potential threats to the public health or welfare or the environment, and actual or threatened releases of hazardous substances to the environment. In summary, U.S. EPA found that several types of hazardous substances are located at the site including inorganic compounds (antimony, arsenic, cadmium, chromium, copper, cyanide, lead, iron, mercury), asbestos-containing material (ACM), and organic compounds such as benzene, carbazole, and polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH). The list of PAHs at the site includes benzo(a)anthracene, benzo(b)fluoranthene, benzo(a)pyrene, benzo(g,h,i)perylene, benzo(k)fluoranthene, chrysene, fluoranthene, indeno(1,2,3-c,d)pyrene, phenanthrene, pyrene, and other similar organics such as dibenzofuran and naphthalene.

In response to the conditions documented in the Site Assessment Report, U.S. EPA entered into a Removal Order with Cliffs Mining Company, Water Street Holdings, LLC, and Wisconsin Wrecking, LLC, to address four primary sources of hazardous substances: 1) asbestos-containing material present in many of the structures, on piping inside and outside structures, and loose asbestos-containing material located on the ground; 2) coal tar from the manufactured gas plant operations located in tanks, piping, on the ground, and in an open pit area; 3) numerous above ground storage tanks and associated piping containing coal tar and other residues; and 4) other hazardous substances located throughout the site such as drums of naphthalene crystals and oil in old electrical transformers. Most of the major coke and gas manufacturing buildings on the northern half of the site were demolished in 2003 when EPA oversaw a hazardous waste removal. The hazardous waste removal included asbestos-containing material in many

of the structures, including on piping inside and outside the structures and loose asbestos-containing material located on the ground; coal tar from the manufactured gas plant operations in tanks, piping, on the ground, and in an open pit area; numerous above-ground storage tanks and associated piping containing coal tar and other residues; and other hazardous substances located throughout the site such as drums of naphthalene crystals and oil in old electrical transformers. On September 6, 2005, U.S. EPA issued a Notice of Completion of On-Site Work for the Removal Order.

The Removal Order did not require the investigation, sampling or excavation and removal of any subsurface hazardous substances or materials. Surface and subsurface contamination not addressed during the removal action remains and is a source of potential exposure to humans and wildlife. In addition, runoff from the site could contain contaminated surface soil which could migrate off-site and enter the river at various locations.

In January 2007 U.S. EPA entered into an Administrative Settlement Agreement and Order on Consent (AOC) with the Potentially Responsible Parties (PRPs) for the conduct of a Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) covering portions of the site. The PRPs that voluntarily signed the AOC include American Natural Resources Company, Cliffs Mining Company, Maxus Energy Corporation, and Wisconsin Electric Power Company and Wisconsin Gas LLC (WE Energies). Also, East Greenfield Investors, LLC, the Debtor's manager and 100% owner, is participating in the agreement as a non-PRP Bonafide Prospective Purchaser. The PRPs and the East Greenfield Investors, LLC are conducting an RI/FS including a baseline risk assessment and ecological assessment at the site. The Remedial Investigation, which includes soil, groundwater, and sediment sampling, began in October 2008. The purpose of the Remedial Investigation is to get a more precise idea of the environmental problems at Solvay. When enough information about the site is gathered, it will be used to complete a document called a remedial investigation report. EPA plans to deem the report "final" in 2016 and make it available to the public. After this report is final, the companies will submit another document for EPA's review and approval called a feasibility study. This study will compare different cleanup options for the site. The EPA will then select a remedy for the affected portions of the site.

Public safety issues.

Apart from the environmental issues, the City of Milwaukee has filed a petition with the Circuit Court for Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, asking for an order compelling Golden Marina to raze seven buildings it deems unfit for human habitation, occupancy, or use. The Debtor has been evaluating contractors to raze the building. Due to apparent asbestos in the buildings and other issues, that process will apparently be very costly.
