

Order Denying Motions (ECF No. 60, 61, 62)

Before the Court are the Motion/Applications at ECF No. 60, 61 and 62 for the following reasons the Motion to Use Cash Collateral, Motion to Compensate Employees, Motion to Compensate Officers are denied, without prejudice:

Service of the Motion/Applications are governed by Bankruptcy Rule 2002. Service of the motion/applications are required on the debtor, the trustee, all creditors and indentured trustees. The debtors certificate of service on each of the motions/applications does not comply with the service requirements of Bankruptcy Rule 2002.

Since proper service is necessary for the Court to have jurisdiction over the responding party, (See *Mason v. Genisco Tech. Corp.*, 960 F 2d 849, 851 (9th Cir. 1992)) failure to properly serve a motion can result in a future challenge to the order granting the relief requested. Therefore, the motion/applications are denied without prejudice.
