



The undersigned, being the directors of H N Hinckley & Sons, Inc., a Massachusetts Corporation (the "Corporation"), hereby adopt, pursuant to M.G.L. c. 156D, § 8.21, the following resolutions, to be effective as of the date set forth above, and hereby direct that the same be filed with the minutes of the meetings of directors of the Corporation as though voted and resolved at a regularly scheduled and noticed meeting of said directors, to wit:

RESOLVED: that the Corporation seek relief under the United States Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101 et seq. (the "Bankruptcy Code") at such time as Wayne M. Guyther III, President, shall deem such relief necessary; and,

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Corporation hereby authorize Wayne M. Guyther III (i) to prepare and file on behalf of the Corporation a petition for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code; (ii) to execute on behalf of the Corporation such petition, schedules and statements as he may deem necessary or appropriate in connection therewith; (iii) to prepare and propose to creditors of the Corporation such plan as he may deem to be feasible and in the best interest of both the Corporation and its creditors; and (iv) to execute such further documents and do such further acts as he may deem necessary or appropriate with respect to the foregoing, including the filing of any petition or motion for relief under any other chapter of the Bankruptcy Code; the execution of any document or the doing of any act by him in connection with such proceedings shall be conclusively presumed to be authorized by this resolution; and

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the law firm of Posternak Blankstein & Lund LLP and Adam J. Ruttenberg, Esq. of that firm, be hereby retained as counsel under general retainer or such other terms and conditions as Wayne M. Guyther III shall approve, to represent the Corporation in all proceedings commenced under or resulting from these resolutions, as well as in connection with all other matters for which the Corporation may need legal advice or representation.


