

## Reclamation Claim Sheet<sup>1</sup>

The reclamation summary included in Exhibit B contains a listing of all reclamation claimants, listed in alphabetical order, by claimant name. The reclamation summary's column headings are defined as follows:

### "Claim Dispatch Date"

The date listed in this column represents the date which the claimant's claim was dispatched to the Debtors. This date was used to determine whether the reclamation claim was timely.

### "Claimed Amount"

The amount listed in this column represents the sum of all invoices included in the reclamation claim.

### "Supported Amount"

The amount listed in this column represents the amount of the claim which is supported by adequate documentation such that the Debtors could identify the goods being reclaimed. To the extent the amount listed in the Supported Amount column is less than the amount in the Claimed Amount column, the Debtors have denied that portion of the claim on the ground that the Debtors have not been provided with adequate documentation to identify the goods being reclaimed.

### "Paid Amount"

The amount listed in this column represents the amount of the Supported Amount, which has been denied on the ground that the vendor has been paid on account of the reclaimed goods prior to the Petition Date.

### "Untimely Claims"

The amount listed in this column represents the amount of the Supported Amount which has been denied on the grounds that either (i) the goods included in the reclamation claim were delivered to the Debtors more than ten (10) days prior to the Petition Date, or (ii) the reclamation claim was not dispatched within twenty (20) days after the delivery of the goods being reclaimed. Claims denied under this category also include claims for goods which were delivered to the Debtors after the bankruptcy petitions were filed.

“Other Adjustments”

The amount listed in this column represents the amount of the Supported Amount which has been denied as a result of the verification process. Reasons for denying a reclamation claimant’s claim under this category include: (i) claims for which the Debtors could not verify receiving the goods claimed in the reclamation claim, (ii) claims for which the Debtors could not verify the amount of reclaimed goods in their possession as of the Claim Dispatch Date,<sup>2</sup> (iii) claims for goods that were delivered to non-debtor third parties, (iv) claims for items that were not goods (freight, services, labor, etc.), (v) claims for goods that were consigned to the Debtors, and (vi) claims for goods in which the reclamation claimant has waived their reclamation rights pursuant to an agreement between the reclamation claimant and the Debtors.

“Inventory Used”

The amount listed in this column represents the amount of the Supported Amount which has been denied on the grounds that the reclaimed goods were not in the Debtors’ inventory system as of the Claim Dispatch Date. A claim may be wholly or partially invalidated.

“Valid Claim”

The amount listed in this column represents the valid amount of the reclamation claimant’s reclamation claim, as determined by the Debtors. Claims may be wholly or partially valid based on whether the entire claim met all of the above criteria.

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<sup>2</sup> The Debtors maintain that, notwithstanding the Debtors’ efforts to verify the delivery of the goods and the amount of the reclaimed goods on hand as of the Claim Dispatch Date, the reclamation claimant ultimately bears the burden of proving each of these element to establish a valid reclamation claim. See Statement of the Debtors Concerning Preliminary Evaluation of Reclamation Claims at pp. 4-5.
