WHEREAS, the Majority have considered the financial and operational aspects of the Company's business;

WHEREAS, the Majority have reviewed the historical performance of the Company, and the current and long-term liabilities of the Company;

WHEREAS, the Majority believes that a restructuring is unlikely to be achieved outside a bankruptcy proceeding due to the Company's highly leveraged financial condition;

WHEREAS, given liquidity constraints and the risk of erosion in the value of the Company's business and assets, the Company has determined that a bankruptcy filing is in the best interests of the Company and its creditors;

RESOLVED, that in the judgment of the majority of the shareholders of the Company, it is in the best interests of the Company, its creditors, and other interested parties that a petition seeking relief under the provisions of chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") be filed by the Company;

RESOLVED, that the manager of the Company be, and hereby is, authorized, empowered and directed, in the name and on behalf of the Company, to execute and verify the petition under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code with respect to the Company and to cause the same to be filed in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Michigan (the "Bankruptcy Court") at such time as the manager executing such petition shall determine;

RESOLVED, that the law firm of Gold, Lange & Majoros, P.C. ("GLM") be, and hereby is, retained as general bankruptcy and corporate counsel for the Company under a general retainer in the Company's chapter 11 case, subject to the approval of the Bankruptcy Court;

RESOLVED, that the Company may retain professionals to perform supplemental legal services, as well as accounting, restructuring and/or financial advisory services for the Company's chapter 11 case, all subject to the approval of the Bankruptcy Court;

connection with the Company's chapter 11 case, with a view to the successful prosecution of such case;
