LETTER AGREEMENT

Driver Transport, LLC (the "Company") Re:

Dear Linda:

Thank you for engaging our law firm to represent the Company concerning the filing of a Chapter 11 petition to address disputes with various creditors. The purpose of this letter is to confirm that our representation of you in a Chapter 11 proceeding will be contingent on the firm's receipt of a retainer in the amount of \$10,000.00, together with a Chapter 11 filing fee of \$1,039.00, and to reiterate our firm's commitment is to provide the highest quality of legal services within the highest ethical standards. In addition, this letter is to set forth our fee arrangement, including a brief general description of the services to be rendered, the staffing which may be necessary to provide these services, and our billing policies and practices.

It is our present understanding that we have been engaged to represent the Company to negotiate a workout of its financial condition. The scope of the services, including the preparation and filing of a Chapter 11 bankruptcy petition and representation of the Company as a Chapter 11 debtor, may be expanded or contracted from time to time by written communications during the course of the engagement. At this time, I will be the only attorney who will be involved in assisting the Company with this matter; however, depending upon the circumstances, additional attorneys, paralegais and law clerks may be called upon to provide services or to accomplish certain tasks.

Because we are sensitive to legal costs, it is our practice to assign work to attorneys and other personnel with going rates consistent with the level of expertise and experience required to perform the work. This firm's fee structure is based upon hourly rates for all attorneys, paralegals, and law clerks unless otherwise specified. Presently, my hourly rate is \$280.00.

Paralegal and law clerk rates are currently \$95.00 per hour. These rates may be changed by the firm in the future, in which case the new rates applicable at the time the work is performed will be utilized for subsequent work. All attorneys, paralegals and law clerks record time expended on hourly fee matters in increments of one-tenth of an hour, which serves as the basis for the hourly charges. Should it be necessary to use other attorneys or professionals, they will be billed at regular hourly rates, which will be similar to those quoted above.

The retainer (and filing fee) paid by you will be held in our firm's trust account. From time to time, you will receive statements reflecting our firm's work-in-progress. This statement will consist of an itemization of all time spent on the case by attorneys and staff, in addition to appurtenant costs and expenses described more fully below. It is our intention to pay the amounts reflected on the statements from the retainer funds on hand; thus, the statements should not be viewed as an invoice for payment unless the retainer is fully utilized prior to completion of our representation. In the event the retainer does not cover the costs of representation, you will be billed monthly as fees and costs are incurred. Upon the filing of the Chapter 11 petition, the existence of any remaining proceeds from the retainer will be disclosed to the Bankruptcy Court. Furthermore, Company agrees that in the event any payment required to be paid by this Agreement is delinquent more than twenty (20) days, firm shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to withdraw from further representation.

It is our firm's practice to itemize all charges advanced on the client's behalf. These charges include the following items: copying charges, fax service, postage, delivery charges, telephone long distance charges, computerized legal research, travel charge and mileage, and other miscellaneous charges which will appear along with the description on your periodic monthly statements.
