STATEMENT REGARDING AUTHORITY TO SIGN AND FILE PETITION

I, JOSEPH HARTNETT, declare under penalty of perjury that I am the Interim Executive Director of THE NEWARK WATERSHED CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, and that the following is a true and correct copy of the resolutions adopted by the Board of Directors of said Corporation at a special meeting duly called and held on the 22 day of DELEMBER, 2014.

WHEREAS, the Newark Watershed Conservation and Development Corporation (the "NWCDC"), is a non-profit corporation organized in 1973 under the State of New Jersey Nonprofit Act.

WHEREAS, in 1900, the City of Newark (the "City") purchased 35,000 acres of property in northern New Jersey, spanning Morris, Passaic and Sussex counties. The purchased property included a number of freshwater reservoirs that have provided drinking water to residents of the City as well as a number of surrounding municipalities. In 1973, the Newark Municipal Council (the "Council") adopted an ordinance authorizing the City to enter into service contracts for the conservation, development and management of the watershed properties. instead of having a City department handle those functions. The Council authorized the thenmayor to establish the NWCDC as a not-for-profit entity that, pursuant to a contract with the City, would manage and plan for the conservation of the watershed properties. In 1998, through a second service contract, NWCDC's responsibilities grew to include operating a major water treatment facility and water storage reservoirs serving 500,000 customers. The NWCDC is governed by a Board of Trustees (the "Board").

WHEREAS, going forward from 1998, the NWCDC became a multi-million dollar operation with some forty employees. Aside from relatively minor income from camping and recreational permit fees, virtually all of the NWCDC's income came from the City of Newark via its service contracts with the City.

WHEREAS, in 2013, the New Jersey Office of the State Comptroller, in response to citizen and taxpayer complaints, conducted an investigation of the NWCDC and in February of 2014 issued a 45-page report detailing allegations of extensive mismanagement and abuse of funds at the NWCDC over multiple years and referring its findings to various criminal and civil law enforcement agencies for follow up investigation. Such investigatory activities of past

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NWCDC actions remain currently ongoing, including the convening of a federal grand jury. The Board, current management and legal counsel of the NWCDC are fully cooperating with these efforts and are coordinating all work necessary to assist.

WHEREAS, while the Office of the State Comptroller was conducting its investigation, the then Board of Trustees of the NWCDC attempted to dissolve itself and abandon operations. In response thereto, on May 24th, 2013, the City of Newark petitioned the Superior Court of New Jersey to intervene in the affairs of the NWCDC. On June 5th, 2013, the Court granted the City's petition for relief and further appointed four new provisional trustees to the Board of the NWCDC for the purpose of overseeing the dissolution of the NWCDC. On July 24, 2013, one of these new trustees resigned for health reasons and was replaced by the Court effective August 24, 2013. Since these provisional trustees were appointed they remained a majority of the governing board through October 2014 and continued to oversee the management of the NWCDC. Among their many major accomplishments has been implementing a complete transfer of all operations, staff, and equipment to the City of Newark, closing-out an active 403(b) retirement program, and completing the first true independent audit of the NWCDC. In furtherance of managing the dissolution of NWCDC, the Board appoints an Executive Director, referred to as the Interim Executive Director pending final dissolution. The Board and Interim Executive Director comprise the management of the NWCDC.

WHEREAS, since termination of its contracts with the City of Newark in 2013 and the concurrent transfer of operations to the City, the NWCDC has no source of income and has been functioning with cash reserves, which are rapidly dwindling and currently stand at less than \$400,000. Claims of creditors substantially exceed assets. The recently completed independent audit of the NWCDC by McEnerney Brady & Co. concluded: "The NWCDC's termination of operations, limited sources of unrestricted cash and funding available raise substantial doubt about the NWCDC's ability to continue as a going concern."

WHEREAS, the Trustees have considered numerous alternative formats for pursing claims held by the NWCDC in determining the amount and validity of claims against the NWCDC, while simultaneously preserving the remaining funds of the NWCDC;

WHEREAS, after evaluating the alternatives available, the Trustees have determined that the filing of a Voluntary Petition under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (11 U.S.C. §1101, et seq.) with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey best facilitates the aforementioned goals to be achieved;

WHEREAS, the Trustees have selected the firm of Wasserman, Jurista & Stolz, P.C. to serve as Bankruptcy Counsel and have negotiated an acceptable blended hourly rate with said firm; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees believe that the continued representation of the NWCDC with regard to all non-bankruptcy matters by the firm of Calcagni & Kanefsky is in the best interest of the NWCDC and the Trustees have negotiated an acceptable blended hourly rate with said firm; and

IT IS ON THIS 22 DAY of _______, 2014 resolved as follows:

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- 1. The Trustees hereby authorize and direct the filing of a Voluntary Bankruptcy Petition, under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Jersey.
- 2. The Trustees authorize the retention of Wasserman, Jurista & Stolz, P.C. as Bankruptcy Counsel, at a blended hourly rate not to exceed the amount of \$395.00 per hour.
- 3. The Trustees hereby authorize the retention of Calcagni & Kanefsky, as General Legal Counsel to the NWCDC during the Chapter 11 Proceedings, at an hourly rate not to exceed \$295.00 per hour.
- 4. The Trustees hereby authorize Joseph Hartnett, Interim Executive Director of the NWCDC to sign the Bankruptcy Petition, the Application for the Retention of Counsel and all other documents and pleadings required to facilitate at the Chapter 11 filing and the obligations of the NWCDC as a Debtor-in-Possession during the Chapter 11 Proceedings.
