





ORDER (A) FURTHER EXTENDING THE DEBTORS' EXCLUSIVE PERIODS TO FILE A CHAPTER 11 PLAN AND SOLICIT ACCEPTANCES THEREOF PURSUANT TO SECTION 1121 OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE, AND (B) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF

Caption: Order (A) Further Extending the Debtors' Exclusive Periods to File a Chapter 11 Plan and Solicit Acceptances Thereof Pursuant to Section 1121 of the Bankruptcy Code, and (B) Granting Related Relief

This matter is before the Court upon the motion (the "Motion")² of the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors") in these chapter 11 cases (the "Chapter 11 Cases") requesting entry of an order (a) further extending the period during which the Debtors have the exclusive right to file a chapter 11 plan (the "Exclusive Filing Period") by approximately 45 days, from March 8, 2018 through and including April 23, 2018, and extending the period during which the Debtors have the exclusive right to solicit votes thereon (the "Exclusive Solicitation Period," and together with the Exclusive Filing Period, the "Exclusive Periods") by an additional 45 days, from May 7, 2018 through and including June 21, 2018, without prejudice to the Debtors' right to seek further extensions of the Exclusive Periods, and (b) granting related relief; and the Court having jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and the *Standing Order of Reference to the Bankruptcy Court Under Title 11* of the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey, as amended on September 18, 2012; and venue being proper in this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and notice of the Motion being sufficient under the circumstances; and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; and the Court having determined that the relief sought in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates and creditors; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is **GRANTED** as set forth herein.
2. Pursuant to section 1121(d) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Debtors' Exclusive Filing Period under section 1121(b) of the Bankruptcy Code is hereby extended through and including April 8, 2018.

3. Pursuant to section 1121(d) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Debtors' Exclusive Solicitation Period under section 1121(c) of the Bankruptcy Code is hereby extended through and including June 6, 2018.

4. Nothing herein shall prejudice (a) the Debtors' right to seek further extensions of the Exclusive Periods consistent with 1121(d) of the Bankruptcy Code, or (b) the rights of any party in interest to object to any requests for further extensions.

5. This Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

6. The Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted pursuant to this Order.

7. This Court shall retain exclusive jurisdiction to hear and decide any and all disputes related to or arising from the implementation, interpretation, or enforcement of this Order.
