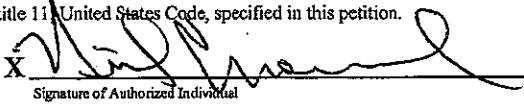

**EURENERGY RESOURCES CORPORATION**

**UNANIMOUS WRITTEN CONSENT OF STOCKHOLDERS IN LIEU OF A MEETING**

WHEREAS, The Articles of Incorporation, as amended, do not prohibit the Stockholders of Eurenergy Resources Corporation (the "Company"), a Nevada corporation, from taking action by consent, and Article III, Meeting of Stockholders, Section 10 of the By-Laws of the Company, specifically permits the taking of any action required or permitted to be taken at any meeting of the Stockholders without a meeting if a written consent to such action is signed by a majority of the Stockholders.

We, the undersigned Stockholders of the Company, Envicon Development Corp. and HRS Holdings, LLC, being the sole Stockholders, pursuant to the provisions of Section 78.315 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, hereby give our unanimous written consent to the following actions and the adoption of the following Resolution without a meeting of the Board of Directors:

WHEREAS, the Company has incurred a judgment debt (the "Judgment Debt") and other business obligations that it cannot pay on a current basis; and

WHEREAS, the Company believes the Judgment Debt resulted from erroneous legal determinations and clearly erroneous fact findings that may be reversed upon appeal; and

WHEREAS, the Company intends to pursue one or more appeals through the Texas appellate system; and

WHEREAS, the Company needs time and the legal rights afforded by the United States Bankruptcy Code to reorganize its financial affairs, maximize the value of its assets for the benefit of creditors and Stockholders, and challenge legally and factually unfounded claims against the Company; and

WHEREAS, after consultation with legal counsel, the Stockholders of the Company have determined that the prompt filing of a Voluntary Petition for relief pursuant to Title 11, Chapter 11 of the United State Code (the "Chapter 11 Petition") would serve the best interests of the Company, its creditors, and its Stockholders; and

WHEREAS, the Company is incorporated in Nevada and may properly file the Chapter 11 Petition in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Nevada (the "Bankruptcy Court"); and

WHEREAS, the Company will need skilled insolvency counsel in Nevada to represent its interests in the Chapter 11 case;

WHEREAS, the Company has determined that law firm of Schartzler & McPherson, in Las Vegas, Nevada, is well-qualified, is "a disinterested person" within the meaning of 11 U.S.C. section 101(14), and is willing to represent the Company's interest in the Chapter 11 case as debtor's counsel, in exchange for a reasonable hourly rate and a retainer;

**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The Company is authorized to file the Chapter 11 Petition in bankruptcy in the Bankruptcy Court on or after April 28, 2010 and initiate a bankruptcy case (the "Bankruptcy Case");
2. The Company is authorized to pursue reorganization in the Bankruptcy Case, which reorganization may entail either a rehabilitation of the Company or a liquidation of its assets or any combination of the two. The Company is further authorized to use any and all legal rights afforded by the United States Bankruptcy Code to a debtor in possession to the fullest extent allowed by applicable law to advance and protect the Company's economic interests, to maximize the value of its assets, and to minimize the amount of claims against the Company's bankruptcy estate;
3. The Company is authorized to seek or give consent to relief from the automatic stay in the Bankruptcy Case to pursue one or more appeals from the Judgment Debt in the Texas appellate system;
4. The Company is authorized to engage the law firm for Schwartzer & McPherson of Las Vegas, Nevada to represent the Company's interests in the Bankruptcy case, as debtor's counsel; and to engage further professionals, such as accountants, auctioneers, expert witnesses, and special counsel, as necessary and appropriate, subject to approval by the Bankruptcy Court;
5. The Company is authorized to pay Schwartzer & McPherson a retainer not to exceed \$75,000, and the pay its normal hourly rate, subject to Bankruptcy Court approval and the laws, Rules, and Guidelines governing professional compensation in the District of Nevada. If the engagement of other professionals becomes necessary, the Company is authorized to do so, and to pay such additional professionals reasonable retainers and reasonable hourly rates, subject to applicable law and Bankruptcy Court approval;
6. The Company authorizes R. Neil Crouch, its President, to act for the Company in the Bankruptcy Case without further approval of the Stockholders or the Board of Directors, subject to any future Resolution of the Stockholders that may revoke, restrict, or modify such authority. Mr. Crouch is authorized to sign bankruptcy papers, including, without limitation, Schedules of Assets and Liabilities, the Statement of Financial Affairs, the Verification of Creditor Matrix, the list of the 20 Largest Unsecured Creditors, and any agreements with counsel, without further approval of the Stockholders or the Board. Mr. Crouch is further authorized to appear in depositions or court as the representative of the Company and to testify on the Company's behalf at depositions or hearings in the Bankruptcy Case. Mr. Crouch is authorized to execute affidavits or declarations as necessary to support pleadings filed by the Company in the Bankruptcy Case. Mr. Crouch is further authorized, subject to Court approval, as required by applicable law, to act for the Company in prosecuting, defending, or compromising any claims held by the Company or claims asserted against the Company in the Bankruptcy Case or in any proceedings that arise in or are related to the Bankruptcy Case.

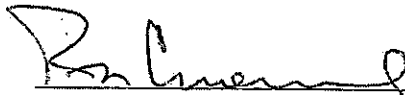
This Unanimous Consent will effective on April 28, 2010, and may be executed in multiple counterparts, all of which together shall constitute but one and the same instrument.

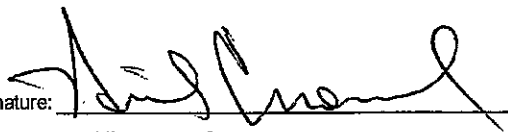

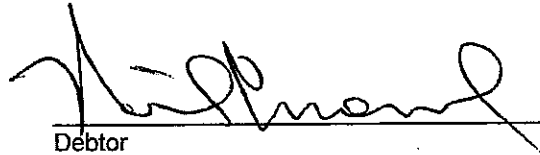
