KIMBERLY CURRY, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. I am the above-named individual debtor and debtor in possession (the “Debtor”). I submit this affidavit pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 1007 in support of my voluntary for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”).

2. I am an individual residing at

My Property and Business

3. I am the owner of Kim & Me, Inc., a closely held corporation of which I own all of the stock. Kim & Me, Inc. currently operates a ladies clothing and accessories boutique at 27 Main Street, Southampton NY 11968.

4. My only significant asset is my principal and only residence located at 50-81 Hubbard Lane, Southampton, NY 11968.

Circumstances Leading to my Chapter 11 Filing

5. Both my business and my personal affairs began to run into serious financial trouble when my relationship with my former companion, George Callas, ended in September 2005. I had incurred significant business and personal expenses prior to that time on the expectation that George would assist me in paying my personal bills and in financing my business, just as he had previously.
6. My break-up with Mr. Callas involved a great deal of nastiness and vindictiveness. Amongst other distractions, Mr. Callas made spurious accusations against me to the Southampton authorities which required me to retain criminal counsel and defend myself. These accusations sapped my energy to operate my business and to manage my personal finances. They also forced me to spend a total of \$25,000.00 in attorneys fees.
7. My difficulties with Mr. Callas, who was acquainted with the landlord of my business at that time, resulted in a situation with that landlord that was so uncomfortable that I felt obligated to move my business to a new location and start afresh. This move, which was also to a larger location, required a significant capital infusion to the business which I had to personally contribute. I obtained the necessary funds to do so by refinancing my condominium located at 50-81 Hubbard Lane, Southampton, NY and contributing \$50,000 in equity from that refinancing to the business, and by taking a \$40,000 personal loan from Wells Fargo Bank.



8. Despite leasing a new store for my business, located at 27 Main Street, Southampton, NY 11968, I had to continue to pay rent at my former business location until the new store was ready for occupancy. Consequently, from January 2006 until August 2006 I was paying rent at two locations, for a total rent of \$8,100 for both locations during this period.
9. During the summer of 2007 I also became involved with an individual named Greg Genari. Feeling overwhelmed operating my business and trying to pay down the personal debts that I had incurred in connection with moving that business as well as my ongoing personal expenses, I trusted Mr. Genari to assist me in operating Kim n Me and in paying my bills, both business and personal. He did neither. When I confronted him he also turned menacing and confrontational. Just as I had to do with Mr. Callas, the situation with Mr. Genari, involving groundless accusations, obligated me to retain the services of a criminal defense attorney and cost me a further \$10,000.00 at a time when I could ill afford to do so.




