JEFFREY PIROZZI, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

- 1. I am the Secretary of the Tudor Oaks Owners Corp. (the "Debtor"), the above-named petitioner.
- 2. The Debtor is a corporation which is engaged in the business of owning a cooperative complex of 105 residential units. The complex is on approximately ten acres and is composed of five buildings located at 101-526 Tudor Lane, Middle Island, New York. Of the 105 units, approximately 35 are owned by the sponsor (Tudor Oaks Associates, Ltd.), and 70 are owned by individual third parties.
- 3. I am advised by counsel that the Debtor is not a "small business" but is a single asset real estate proceeding as the terms are defined in the Bankruptcy Code.
- 4. The Debtor has personal property with an approximate value of \$90,000.00 comprised of, among other things, cash in the sum of \$1,000,00 account receivables with a value of \$85,000.00, and machinery and equipment with a value of \$3,000.00. The Debtor has real property with an approximate value of \$1,750,000.00.

The Debtor's liabilities total approximately \$3,240,000.00, of which \$11,000.00 represents priority claims, \$3,200,000.00 represents secured creditors' claims and \$128,000.00 represents unsecured creditors' claims.

- 5. At this time, no property of the Debtor is in the possession or custody and control of any public officer, receiver, trustee or assignee for the benefit of creditors, mortgages, pledges or assignees. There are (2) actions currently pending against the Debtor in the Supreme Court of the State of New York in Suffolk County, one of which bears Index Number 08-30406 with the following party as plaintiff: James V. Diodato, et al. This action is disputed and is still in the discovery stage. The other action which, upon information and belief, does not have an index number at this time, is as follows: Winter Bros. Recycling Corp. v. Tudor Oaks Owners Corp. This action is also disputed.
- 6. A list of the creditors holding the twenty (20) largest unsecured claims against the Debtor's estate, together with their addresses and the amount due, is annexed to the Debtor's petition. A schedule of secured creditors is also annexed hereto which reflects that the Debtor has two secured creditor holding claims in the approximate amount of \$3,200,000.00.
- 7. The Debtor's payroll including taxes for its one full time and one part-time employee for the thirty (30) day period following the filing of the petition herein is approximately \$4,000.00. None of its officers receive any compensation from the Debtor. For its first thirty days, its operations on a cash basis in this proceeding should be on a break-even basis, as per the annexed schedule. The operations of the Debtor since its inception were managed by its Board of Directors and by "Perozzi Management" who monthly receives \$2,400.00. Perozzi Management has been in the

business of managing real property for over twenty years and manages other residential complexes in the metropolitan area.

- 8. The two secured creditors in its proceeding hold liens (mortgages and security interest) on substantially all of the Debtor's assets. The Debtor has defaulted on its payments to its secured creditors because its cash flow has not been sufficient to pay same. Its lack of cash flow has been caused by two main reasons. First, certain of its unit owners did not make their maintenance payments and owe in excess of \$100,000.00. Second, the Debtor has been required to expend an unusual amount of its revenues for repairs to the complex and to bring its operating system up to the requirements of the Amended Fire Code.
- 9. The two secured creditors have indicated they intend to institute foreclosure actions on their mortgages. Their purpose for such actions would be to become the owners of the complex's 105 units and terminate the ownership interest and proprietary lease of the unit owners. Accordingly, the Debtor's filing is necessitated to preserve its assets and maintain the ownership interest and residences of its unit owners and leasees. If the secured creditors foreclose on their mortgages, the unit owners' proprietary leases would be terminated with the serious potential consequences that over 100 people (some of which are elderly and some who have made all their payments) will have to find new residences as they will be tossed into the street.
- 10. The Debtor for the first thirty days of its proceeding will have a positive cash flow, as per the annexed schedule.
- 11. The Debtor believes that with the protection of this Court, it will be able to maintain and preserve its assets, restructure its mortgages and debts, and propose a

meaningful and acceptable plan of reorganization to its creditors. Prepetition, the Debtor was not able to restructure its debts.

WHEREFORE, your Deponent prays that the Debtor be continued in the operation and management of its business and affairs pending further order of this Court.
