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### CERTIFICATION UNDER LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULE 1007-4

Charles Kofman, hereby affirms the following under the penalties of perjury:

- 1. Affirmant is the manager of Manor Ventures, LLC, the debtor in this Chapter 11 case and submits this affidavit pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 1007-4 for the Eastern District.
- 2. This is an original voluntary Chapter 11 petition. The debtor is the owner of three parcels of property located in Sullivan County, New York. The properties at 15 High Street, Monticello, New York and 320 Rockland Road, Roscoe, New York, were both former medical facilities that operated as a hospital or nursing homes by the prior owners. The property in the Town of Colchester is the parking lot associated with the Roscoe property. The debtor is not a small business debtor within the meaning of Bankruptcy Code 101(51D).
- 3. Annexed to this petition is a list of the debtor's 20 largest unsecured creditors pursuant to Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 1007(d).

- 4. There are three lawsuits pending against the debtor as follows:
- (a) <u>In re Foreclosure of 2011 Tax Liens, etc., County</u> Court, State of New York, County of Sullivan, index number 2011-2011.
- (b) <u>FNBJ Holding Corp. v. Landfield-Monticello Services</u>

  <u>Inc. et. al.</u>, Supreme Court, County of Sullivan, Index No. 1828-2009

  (assigned to Upstate Manor Equities Ltd.).
- (c) Yeager Realty Associates and Myrna Ginsberg Real Estate v. Landfield-Monticello Services, Inc. and Manor Ventures LLC, Index No. 1555-2009.
- 5. The debtor purchased the Monticello and Roscoe properties after they had been closed by the prior owners due to failed inspections by the New York State Department of Health.
- (a) The debtor intended to remodel the properties and sell them. However, several heavy winters have caused severe damage to the debtor's buildings, which prevented renovation and resale.
- (b) Also, this past year there was heavy vandalism with the removal of copper tubing and pipes, which left the interior of the debtor's buildings in shambles. In addition, the debtor has experienced very high real estate taxes, including extremely large penalties and interest.
- (c) The debtor plans to remedy these problems by resolving the real estate obligations and settling the outstanding mortgage obligation through a sale of the properties or a lease with an option to buy. The debtor has already expended significant funds on cleaning out both premises and making major repairs to the roofs.

- The debtor is engaged in pending negotiations with (d) independent third parties for purchase of both premises for use as assisted living projects and also, with a local municipality for use as a homeless shelter.
- The problem of the debtor's properties having been overtaxed has hindered the development of the properties. The debtor expects to remedy this situation by pursuing its rights under Section 505 of the Bankruptcy Code.
- Once the debtor has successfully leased the premises with an option to buy, the value of the properties will greatly increase to a value in excess of \$2,000,000.
- The debtor has also been negotiating with the mortgagee on the properties, who has evidenced a willingness to extend the mortgage in connection with a lease or sale, or in the alternative, take a substantial discount for a one time payment.
- The debtor has no operating income for the next 30 days. The expenses for the operation of the debtor's business, excluding debt service, is \$596.00 per month, over the next 30 days is estimated to be as follows:

- There will be no payroll for the debtor's manager or member for the next 30 days.
- There are two secured creditors of the debtor, which are as follows:

- (a) The claim of Upstate Manor Equities Ltd., as assignee of FNBJ Holding Corp., is based on a first mortgage that has been spread upon all three properties owned by the debtor. The outstanding claim is \$500,000 and the aggregate value of the properties is \$725,000.
- (b) Sullivan County real estate tax liens on the properties located at 15 High Street, Monticello, New York in the sum of \$154,531.06 and 320 Rockland Road, Roscoe, New York in the sum of \$83,068.36.
- 9. None of the debtor's equity interest is publicly held. Charles Kofman is the sole equity holder and member of the debtor.
