Rubani Bueno, declares the following pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746:

1. I am the President and sole shareholder of Arjo Food Corp (the "Debtor"). I submit this Declaration in accordance with Local Bankruptcy Rule 1007-2 in support of the Debtor's filing of a voluntary petition ("Petition") under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

### I. Background

- 2. The Debtor operates a 5,500 square foot retail supermarket at 5817 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue in the Sunset Park section of Brooklyn NY (the "Premises") under the banner "America's Food Basket", employing approximately seventeen (17) full-time and part-time employees. The Debtor paid \$800,000 to acquire the supermarket in 2012, and thereafter invested another \$500,000 to remodel and upgrade the store.
- 3. The Debtor occupies the Premises pursuant to certain lease dated October 27, 2011 as modified on May 8, 2018 and as further amended on May 17, 2018 (collectively the "Lease"), with Grafstein Associates LLC as landlord (the "Landlord"). The Debtor's monthly base rent is \$9,500 a month. The Debtor is also obligated to pay real estate charges, which are

the subject of an ongoing dispute and controversy with the Landlord because of the Landlord's failure to obtain additional tenants for the upstairs portion of the building to mitigate the Debtor's tax obligations.

### II. Lead-Up to Chapter 11

- 4. The Debtor's Chapter 11 case is filed for several reasons: first, over the last few years, business volume at the supermarket has dropped due to increased competition in the surrounding neighborhood and the Debtor's lack of capital to remain competitive. At its peak, the Debtor maintained sales of between \$90,0000-100,000 per week, only to witness a drop in volume to a current level of between \$55,000-60,000 per week. Second, the Debtor's rent and lease obligations have increased because the Debtor is responsible for all real estate taxes associated with the property in the absence of an upstairs tenant.
- 5. The Debtor cannot exist at these sales levels, and is seeking Chapter 11 relief in contemplation of selling the supermarket in bankruptcy.
- 6. Substantially all of the Debtor's operating assets are subject to a first lien held by Savoy Bank which is owed approximately \$2,059,010.50. Certain other creditors (chiefly, America's Food Basket) have filed financing statements against the Debtor. However, the value of the collateral held by Savoy Bank, as first lienholder, is less than the amount of the Savoy Bank debt, leaving the other junior lienholders under-secured for purposes of bankruptcy.
- 7. Just prior to bankruptcy, Savoy Bank closed the Debtor's operating account, and the Debtor is COD with its current main supplier, Krasdale Foods. With the filing of the Chapter 11 case, the Debtor hopes to resume its banking relationship with Savoy Bank. After the closure of the bank account last week, I have paid certain supermarket bills through another company which I own known as RGR LLC.

#### III. Reorganization Strategy

- 8. While the situation is tenuous, there is reason to believe that the Chapter 11 case can have a positive ending. Specifically, the Debtor hopes to complete negotiations for the sale of the supermarket in the upcoming weeks for a price of approximately \$1 million. The sale of the supermarket shall be made subject to competitive bidding, and the Debtor will seek the best return possible.
- 9. While Savoy Bank holds a first lien on the Debtor's operating assets, the extent and scope of this lien in terms of whether it properly includes and covers the Debtor's lease is still to be decided. The Debtor will seek to negotiate an allocation of an anticipated purchase price with Savoy Bank and its counsel to enable the Debtor to offer a reorganization plan to pay taxes and other creditors.
- 10. A sale of the supermarket represents the best opportunity for the Debtor's estate to realize "going concern" value for the business, although compromises will need to be obtained from various creditors to make a sale possible. The Debtor believes that there is a basis for compromise, since it is not clear that any creditor holds a properly perfected lien on the Debtor's lease.
- 11. The Debtor also intends to commence an adversary proceeding against the Landlord to reduce the Debtor's liability for real estate taxes in light of the Landlord's refusal or inability to obtain another tenant for the upstairs premises.

#### IV. Local Rule 1007 Disclosures

12. Pursuant to Local Rule 1007-2(a)(2) and (3), a committee of creditors was not formed prior to the filing of the Chapter 11 petition.

- 13. Pursuant to Local Rule 1007-2(a)(4), a list of the names and addresses of the creditors holding the Debtor's largest unsecured claims is annexed to the Petition. The Debtor has less than twenty (20) unsecured claims.
- 14. Pursuant to Local Rule 1007-2(a)(5), the Debtor has other disputed secured creditors, with Savoy Bank appearing to have a first priority lien as set forth below.

- 15. Pursuant to Local Rule 1007-2(a)(6), a summary of the Debtor's assets and liabilities is set forth in the accompanying bankruptcy schedules. Essentially, the Debtor's supermarket has a projected value of approximately \$1 million as a going concern, while the Debtor's supermarket assets have far less value in liquidation.
- 16. Pursuant to Local Rule 1007-2(a)(7), a list of the equity holders of the Debtor is also attached to the petition, naming the undersigned as the sole shareholder, officer and director.
- 17. Pursuant to Local Rule 1007-2(a)(8), none of the Debtor's assets is in the possession of a custodian, public officer, mortgagee, pledgee, assignee of rents or secured creditor.
- 18. Pursuant to Local Rule 1007-2(a)(9), the Debtor's has no interests in real property other than the Lease.
- 19. Pursuant to Local Rule 1007-2(a)(10), the Debtor's books and records are maintained at its business premises in Brooklyn, NY. The Debtor's accountant is Mel Fastow, CPA of Interactive Business Services.

20. Pursuant to Local Rule 1007-2(a)(12), I am the President of the Debtor and I receive a salary of \$1,500 per week, depending on available cash flow. The store payroll is approximately \$10,000 per week.
