- I am a licensed real estate broker and the President of International Properties
 Group, Inc. This affidavit is submitted pursuant to Rule 1007-2 of the Local Bankruptcy Rules of this Court.
- 2. On July 23, 2010, I filed a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") with this Court. No committee of creditors has been appointed.
- 3. My chapter 11 filing was precipitated by the entry of a money judgment against me (among others) in a lawsuit titled *Air China Limited v. Nelson LI*, *et al.*, Docket No. 07-cv-11128 (LTS) (DFE), pending before the United States District Court for the Southern District of

New York (the "Air China Litigation"). The Air China Litigation involved allegations of a purported scheme to defraud Air China in connection with a real property development project. My portion of the judgment amount totals approximately \$515,600.00 representing compensatory and punitive damages.

- 4. My personal assets are located at 79 Erie Street, Campbell Hall, New York.
- 5. Pursuant to LBR 1007-2 (a)(4), a list containing the names and addresses of what I believe to be the twenty largest unsecured creditors, excluding insiders, has been or shortly will be filed with the Court.
- 6. Pursuant to LBR 1007-2 (a)(5), a list containing the names and addresses of what I believe are all of my secured creditors have been listed in my Schedule D which has been or shortly will be filed with the Court.
- 7. Pursuant to LBR 1007-2 (a)(6), an approximate summary of my assets and liabilities are set forth in my Schedules B, D, E and F which have been or shortly will be filed with the Court..
