



DECLARATION OF CIRILO RODRIGUEZ PURSUANT TO LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULE 1007-2

Cirilo Rodriguez, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

- I am the Sole Member and Managing Member of 173 Cortlandt Street LLC ("Debtor"). As such, I am fully familiar with the Debtor's operations, business and financial affairs.
- I submit this Declaration pursuant to Rule 1007(d) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure ("Bankruptcy Rules") and Rule 1007-2 of the Local Rules for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York ("Local Rules").

Local Rule 1007-2(a)(1)

3. The Debtor is a single asset real estate entity that owns and operates a multifamily building located at 173 Cortlandt Street, Sleepy Hollow, New York 10591 ("Property"). The building consists of a 3 story apartment building with

- 2 commercial units, one of which is currently rented and the other is not and 4 residential units all of which are currently rented.
- 4. The Property has an approximate fair market value of \$1,500,000.00 and has a first secured mortgage in the approximate outstanding amount of \$500,000.00 and a second mortgage in the approximate outstanding amount of \$300,000.00 both held by Salpa Holdings LLC.
- 5. The Debtor has properly and consistently insured, maintained and managed the Property. The Debtor has a substantial rent roll from tenants and has the ability to continue to service the mortgage debt pending a refinance, sale or confirmation of a Plan of Reorganization within a reasonable amount of time.
- 6. The Debtor's bankruptcy filing was necessitated by the imminent appointment and qualification of a receiver of the Property in a foreclosure action titled Salpa Holdings LLC v. 173 Cortlandt Street, LLC, et al., New York Supreme Court, Westchester County, Index No. 52399/2015 ("Foreclosure Action"). The Foreclosure Action was precipitated primarily by the Debtor's inability to refinance the mortgage which was itself occasioned by the failure of a new lender with whom it had negotiated for months deciding at the last minute (the day of the closing in late October 2014) to not fund the loan. By then, the Debtor had spent tens of thousands of dollars to obtain a loan to refinance the mortgages encumbering the Property.
- 7. The Debtor intends within 60 days to be able to refinance the Property which will result in the payment of its obligations to Salpa Holdings LLC in full.
