The Debtor is authorized, in accordance with the terms of the August Order (except as modified herein) and the cash collateral budget (the "<u>Budget</u>") annexed hereto as **Exhibit** "A", to use AFP's cash collateral (as such term is defined in 11 U.S.C. § 363(a)) as set forth in the Budget through and including January 31, 2012, without prejudice to further extensions.
