**CONSENT ORDER REGARDING EMERGENCY
MOTION TO USE CASH COLLATERAL OF UNITED BANK**

AND NOW, this 9th day of October, 2018, upon consideration of the Motion of the debtor, Apex Cleaning Supply, Inc. (the "Debtor") to Use the Cash Collateral of United Bank (the "Motion"), it is hereby ORDERED that said Motion is GRANTED; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtor may use the insurance proceeds resulting from damage to its 2007 Ford E50 Van, which constitute cash collateral of United Bank pursuant to the Final Order Authorizing the Use of Cash Collateral (the "Cash Collateral Order") [Docket No. 79], for the purchase of a new vehicle to be used by the Debtor for its business operations; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtor may use the insurance proceeds resulting from damage to its 2006 Chrysler Town & County (collectively with the insurance proceeds related to the 2007 Ford E50 Van, the "Insurance Proceeds"), which constitute cash collateral of United Bank pursuant to the Cash Collateral Order, for the purchase of a new vehicle to be used by the Debtor for its business operations; and it is further


ORDERED that United Bank shall have a first lien on any vehicle purchased by the Debtor with the Insurance Proceeds, and the Debtor shall immediately upon purchase cause such lien to be noted on the paper title of any such vehicle or shall immediately provide such paper title to United Bank so that United Bank can perfect its lien; and it is further

ORDERED that, to the extent that the Debtor uses the Insurance Proceeds to pay off any debts on any other vehicles on which United Bank is a junior lienholder, pursuant to the Cash Collateral Order, which results in United Bank becoming a first lienholder on such vehicles, the

Debtor shall immediately cause such lien to be noted on the paper title of any such vehicle or shall immediately provide such paper title to United Bank so that United Bank can perfect its lien.
