WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Corporation has determined that it is desirable and in the best interest of the Corporation, its creditors, stockholders and other interested parties, that the Corporation file a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the filing by the Corporation of a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania (the "Bankruptcy Court") be, and it hereby is, authorized and approved;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that each officer of the Corporation (each, a "Proper Officer") be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and empowered, in the name of the Corporation, to execute and verify a petition for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code and to cause the same to be filed with the Bankruptcy Court at such time as such officer shall determine;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that each Proper Officer be, and each of them hereby is, authorized to execute and file on behalf of the Corporation all petitions, schedules, lists, documents, pleadings and other papers and to take any and all action that they may deem necessary or proper in connection with the chapter 11 case of the Corporation;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that each Proper Officer be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and directed to retain the law firm Whiteford, Taylor & Preston, L.L.P. to render legal services to and to represent the Corporation in connection with such chapter 11 case and other related matters in connection therewith, upon such terms and conditions as such officers shall approve;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that each Proper Officer be, and each of them hereby is, authorized to retain such other professionals as they deem necessary and appropriate to represent, assist or consult with the Corporation during the chapter 11 case;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that each Proper Officer be, and each of them hereby is, authorized to obtain any Debtor in Possession financing for the Corporation in such amount as such Proper Officer deems appropriate, on such terms and with such collateral as such Proper Officer finds to be reasonable, all such loans being subject to the approval of the Bankruptcy Court;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that each Proper Officer be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and directed to take any and all further actions and to execute and deliver any and all further instruments and documents and pay all expenses (subject to Bankruptcy Court approval, where necessary), in each case as in their judgment shall be necessary or desirable in order to fully carry out the intent and accomplish the purpose of the resolutions adopted herein; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all acts lawfully done or actions lawfully taken by any and each Proper Officer, which are necessary to effectuate the intent of the resolutions adopted herein, are hereby in all respects ratified, confirmed, and approved;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Consent may be executed in counterparts and each of such fully executed counterparts shall be deemed an original and it shall not be necessary in making proof of this consent to produce or account for more than one such counterpart; and,


