I. INTRODUCTION

Pursuant to Section 1125 of the United States Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C. § 101, *et seq.* (the "Bankruptcy Code"), Empresa Local Global, Inc., debtor and debtor-in-possession in the above captioned case ("Debtor"), submits its Disclosure Statement (the "Disclosure Statement") to all of its known creditors and parties in interest in the captioned case. The purpose of the Disclosure Statement is to provide such information as Debtor believes may be deemed necessary for Debtor's creditors to make an informed decision in exercising their rights to vote on Debtor's Plan (the "Plan"), dated as of the date of the Disclosure Statement. The Plan is being filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Puerto Rico ("Bankruptcy Court")¹ simultaneously herewith.

Debtor recommends that you vote to accept the Plan. Each creditor must, however, review the Plan and the Disclosure Statement carefully, including all Exhibits in their entirety, and determine whether or not to accept or reject the Plan based upon that creditor's independent judgment and evaluation. The description of the Plan in the Disclosure Statement is in summary form and is qualified by reference to the actual terms and conditions of the Plan, which should be reviewed carefully before making a decision to accept or reject the Plan. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein have the same meaning as set forth in the Plan, other terms shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Bankruptcy Code.

The information contained in the Disclosure Statement has been provided by Debtor based upon Debtor's knowledge of its records, business, and affairs. Except as otherwise expressly indicated, the information provided by Debtor in the Disclosure

Statement has not been subject to an audit or independent review. Although great efforts have been made to be accurate, Debtor, its counsel and other professional advisors do not warrant the accuracy of the information contained herein.

The Disclosure Statement has not yet been approved by the Bankruptcy Court as providing information deemed adequate to permit Debtor's creditors to make an informed judgment in exercising their right to vote for or against the Plan.

No representations concerning Debtor, including the value of its assets, or the aggregate dollar amount of claims which may be allowed are authorized other than as set forth in the Disclosure Statement. Any representations, warranties or agreements made to secure acceptance or rejection of the Plan by Debtor's creditors that differ from those contained in the Disclosure Statement should not be relied upon in voting on the Plan.

Debtor believes that the Plan provides the quickest recovery and will maximize the return to creditors on their Claims. **ACCORDINGLY, DEBTOR URGES ALL CREDITORS TO VOTE IN FAVOR OF THE PLAN.**

II. SUMMARY OF THE PLAN

The Plan specifies the manner in which the Claims and Interest in the Debtor are to be treated. Allowed Administrative Expense Claims and Allowed Priority Tax Claims are not classified for purposes of voting under the Plan, but the Plan does provide for the treatment of such Claims. The table below provides a summary of the treatment of those claims and of the Class of Claims against Debtor, as well as that of Debtor's shareholder's interest in Debtor. To the extent that the terms of the Disclosure Statement vary from those of the Plan, the terms of the Plan will control.

The Disclosure Statement has been prepared by Debtor to provide creditors with adequate information so that they can make an informed judgment about the Plan.

Each creditor should read the Disclosure Statement and the Plan in their entirety before voting on the Plan. No solicitation of votes on the Plan may be made except pursuant to the Disclosure Statement and no person has been authorized to utilize any information concerning Debtor's assets other than the information contained herein for purposes of solicitation.

III. INFORMATION ABOUT THE REORGANIZATION PROCESS

3.1 Purpose of a Disclosure Statement

The Disclosure Statement includes background information about Debtor and identifies the class into which creditors and the equity holder have been placed by the Plan. It describes the proposed treatment of each of those Classes if the Plan is confirmed and contains information concerning the prospects in the event of confirmation or, in the alternative, the prospects if confirmation is denied or the proposed Plan does not become effective.

Upon its approval by the Bankruptcy Court, the Disclosure Statement and its Exhibits will have been found to contain, in accordance with the provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, adequate information of a kind and in sufficient detail to enable a reasonable, hypothetical investor, typical of a holder of an impaired claim or an interest to make an informed judgment about the Plan. Approval of the Disclosure Statement, however, does not constitute a recommendation by the Bankruptcy Court either for or against the Plan.

3.2 Voting Procedure

Since there are no impaired classes, and thus, Classes 1 and 2 are unimpaired and not entitled to vote since they are conclusively presumed to have accepted the Plan pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §1126 (f), there will not be voting on the Plan.

3.3 The Confirmation Hearing

Pursuant to Section 1128 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Court has scheduled a hearing on confirmation of the Plan to commence on _____ **2017 at ____M.**, or as soon thereafter as the parties can be heard. The Confirmation Hearing will be held before the Honorable Brian K. Tester, United States Bankruptcy Judge, 300 Recinto Sur Street, San Juan, Puerto Rico 00901, or before such other Bankruptcy Judge and at such other place as may be indicated in the future.

At the Confirmation Hearing, the Bankruptcy Court will consider whether the Plan satisfies the various requirements of the Bankruptcy Code, including whether it is feasible and in the best interests of holders of claims and interests. The Bankruptcy Court will also receive and consider a Report of Plan Voting prepared by Debtor, summarizing the votes for acceptance or rejection of the Plan by parties entitled to vote.

The Confirmation Hearing may be adjourned from time to time without further notice except for the announcement of the adjourned date made at the Confirmation Hearing or at any subsequent adjourned Confirmation Hearing.

At the Confirmation Hearing with respect to the Plan, the Bankruptcy Court will (i) determine whether the requisite votes have been obtained for each Class, (ii) hear and determine objections, if any, to the Plan and to the confirmation of the Plan, that have not been previously disposed of, (iii) determine whether the Plan meets the confirmation requirements of the Bankruptcy Code, and (iv) determine whether to confirm the Plan.

Any objection to confirmation of the Plan must be in writing, filed and served as required by the Bankruptcy Court pursuant to the order approving the Disclosure

Statement, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit B** hereto.

IV. GENERAL INFORMATION

4.1 Debtor's Description, Historical View and Events Preceding Debtor's Chapter 11 filing

During 1983, more than thirty (30) years ago, Mr. José Martínez Cancañón ("Martínez"), Debtor's president and shareholder, commenced the business of selling wooden prefabricated houses in Puerto Rico (the "Houses") under the name of Casas Mi Estilo, until the creation of Casas Mi Estilo, Inc., now Debtor, on August 17, 1987, who sold them until 2004.

On May 12, 1993, as it appears from deed number 43 before Notary Public Waldemar Del Valle Armstrong, then Casas Mi Estilo, Inc., thereafter Debtor, purchased from Motoramerica Incorporada a parcel of land of 3,876.38 square meters at Urbanización Industrial San Rafael, Ponce, Puerto Rico, for \$484,547.50 (the "Parcel of Land").

On September 3, 1999, the directors of Casas Mi Estilo, Inc. authorized Mr. Martínez to register "Casas Mi Estilo" as a trademark, to preclude its copying by others and for it being able to be utilized as a registered trademark.

On October 8, 1999, the trademark was registered at the Department of State of Puerto Rico for ten (10) years.

On February 15, 2000, Casas Mi Estilo, Inc.'s name was changed to Debtor's.

On February 18, 2000, Empresas Cancañón, Inc. ("Cancañón") was created by Mr. Martínez and his brother Eduardo Martínez Cancañón to undertake the selling of the Houses under the name of Casas Mi Estilo. These changes were undertaken to transfer the sale of the Houses from Debtor to Cancañón, leaving Debtor as a real estate

corporation. Since 2004, Debtor has been exclusively a real estate corporation not being involved in the sale of the Houses.

The operations of Cancañón were undertaken in a portion of the Parcel of Land later sold to Furiel Auto Corp. ("Furiel").

On November 5, 2005, Cancañón's directors authorized a \$225,000.00 loan to Debtor for Debtor to build some commercial spaces on the Parcel of Land, in accordance to its real estate purposes.

As it appears from Deed Number 2 before Notary Public Gamaliel Rodríguez López, on June 20, 2014, Debtor sold to Furiel 1,478.906 square meters from the Parcel of Land, for \$427,000.00, where Furiel sells Toyota brand motor vehicles, resulting in the Parcel of Land being reduced to 1,397.473 square meters. (the "Realty").

The sale to Furiel was undertaken to pay off the balance due on the defaulted mortgage on the Parcel of Land to Oriental Bank (\$200,000.00) and to pay Cancañón \$190,000.00, of the \$225,000.00 loan, through checks number 007-0010, to enable Cancañón to attempt to deal with the financial disaster caused by DACO's negative statements through the media, as to certain delays in the delivery of some of the Houses, creating hysteria and chaos on all pending deliveries. The balance of \$37,000.00 was paid to various of Cancañón's suppliers, primarily Dantzler. Thus, Debtor does not owe anything to Cancañón, in consonance to what is stated on Debtor's Amended Schedule F; thus, nothing is owed to Cancañón. The full sale proceeds arising from the sale to Furiel were deposited in Debtor's bank account.

All the funds paid back by Debtor to Cancañón were destined to reimburse customers' deposits, who were demanding payment in no uncertain terms, payroll, services, and suppliers who demanded payment in cash in advance as a condition of

delivering the material needed for the construction of the Houses.

Cancañón's four (4) model Houses were located in the portion of the Parcel of Land sold to Furiel at the time of the filing of Cancañón's Chapter 7 petition and had to be removed therefrom. They were disassembled by Cancañón's management and its components stored.

Since before the filing of Debtor's and Cancañón's bankruptcy petitions, respectively on August 11 and 14, 2014, DACO falsely advocated that they were one and the same, creating confusion in doing so, and prompting purchasers of the Houses to file duplicate proofs of claim in both bankruptcy cases, when the facts were and are otherwise. Debtor and Cancañón have always been separate and distinct corporate entities.

During the period of Cancañón's creation, from 2000 to 2004, Debtor continued to sell the Houses until the completion of Cancañón's permitting process and business plan. Cancañón commenced the sale of the Houses in 2005.

To underscore DACO's undertaking against Debtor, on July 1, 2014, DACO filed a complaint in Case No. KAC2014-0637, before the Court of First Instance of Puerto Rico, San Juan Section ("Court of First Instance"), in which, inter alia, DACO went on blindsidely to sue Debtor and unrelated parties to the sale of the Houses by Cancañón, creating the confusion which remains in the captioned case to date, and which Debtor clarified through the objection to claim process trumped by the Court at the hearing of September 9, 2016 (the "Hearing"). DACO's complaint requested, as provisional remedies, the cessation of the defendants', not Cancañón's business and the appointment of a Trustee, vacuously granted by the Court of First Instance, until the day of the hearing scheduled for August 6, 2014, furthering the chaos and confusion.

Debtor has filed omnibus objections to the aforesaid duplicatively filed proofs of claim in this case for the purpose of moving on with its reorganization process (Docket Nos. 227, 228, 229, 230, and 237), as to which objections at least 41 answers have been filed by different improperly filing claimants. (Docket Nos. 232, 239-252, 255, 258-274, 276-280).

The objections to such claims were properly served on the objected to claimants, as provided for in Rule 3007 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

The Court held the Hearing of the proofs of claim listed in Debtor's first omnibus objection (Docket No. 281). The second (Docket No. 228), third (Docket No. 229), and fourth (Docket No. 230) omnibus objections to claims have not been scheduled for a hearing.

Debtor appeared at the Hearing represented by Mr. Martínez and its present counsel, ready to meet its burden under Section 502 of the Bankruptcy Code. Also represented by counsel were the claimants identified with proofs of claim number 72, 82, 106, 113, 114, 115, 122, 138, 319, and 375.

To Debtor's surprise, instead of the Hearing being on the scheduled objections to the proofs of claim, all of which were denied for several procedural reasons by the Court, without Debtor's due process being preserved, outside of its scope, the Hearing became prosecutorial in nature with the then presiding Judge becoming an advocate against Debtor (Docket No. 288).

In doing so, the presiding Judge not only crossed the judicial line of an impartial adjudicator of facts, becoming adversarial, to say the least, ipso facto, also without any evidence, piercing Debtor and Cancañón's corporate veils, confusing one with the other, forgetting that both cases are more than two years old, that in Cancañón a Chapter 7

Trustee is in place, both having been monitored by the office of the U.S. Trustee and that in none any concerns have been raised or actions of any nature undertaken against anyone by either the Chapter 7 Trustee or the U.S. Trustee.

The Court even took judicial notice outside the scope of the Federal Rule of Evidence 201 by making reference to the presiding Judge's visit in Ponce to Casa de los Tornillos, to conclude that the four (4) model Houses existing close thereto at the time of the filing of Cancañón's Chapter 11 were no longer there and that "[n]ow cars from a Toyota dealer ("Furiel") occupy the space where the houses used to be", without any evidence as to why in any event those four Houses listed in Cancañón's Schedule A to its Chapter 7 petition, not in Debtor's, as to whom the Hearing was scheduled regarding its objections to claims, were disassembled and thus irrelevant to the issues before the Court.

All of these, without any prior notice to Debtor of the Court's intended nature of the hearing and an opportunity for Debtor to prepare itself accordingly.

To Mr. Martínez's representations, through the Debtor's present counsel, that the four (4) Houses had been taken down with the consent of the Chapter 7 Trustee in Cancañón's case, the presiding judge stated that the Trustee had not abandoned them nor had anyone moved to lift the stay to "demolish" them in the Chapter 7 case.

Without more, the Court found Mr. Martínez's allegations "troubling" and directed the Chapter 7 Trustee and the U.S. Trustee to investigate the matter and submit their position in 30 days as to Debtor's "allegations that the Chapter 7 Trustee authorized the demolition of property of the Chapter 7 estate without complying with any of the provisions of the Bankruptcy Code."

In turn, the Court directed Debtor to show cause, within thirty (30) days as to

why the Debtor's Chapter 11 case should not be converted to Chapter 7 due to the alleged unauthorized "destruction" of Cancañón's four (4) model Houses, without any evidence that they were disassembled by Debtor and the reason therefor, nor who the removing person or party was, scheduling a hearing on the order to show cause for November 16, 2016 at 9:30 a.m.

As to be expected, considering the nature of the Court's admonishment, reflective that his fiduciary responsibilities could be in jeopardy, through the United States Trustee's motion in compliance with the Court's order of September 27, 2016, the Chapter 7 Trustee in Cancañón's case, Roberto Román Valentín, Esq., denied having authorized or directed the disassembling of the four (4) model Houses. (Docket No. 290).

This is in sharp contract to Mr. Román's Individual Estate Property Record and Report of October 30, 2015, wherein, notwithstanding Cancañón's valuation of the four (4) model Houses in \$80,000.00, Mr. Román lists them with zero value (Exhibit 1) and Debtor's former counsel Anibal Medina Rios, Esq.'s, ("Medina"), unanswered e-mail of September 16, 2016 (Exhibit 1A).

Further, corroborating Mr. Martínez's representations and Mr. Medina's e-mail are the following factors:

- a) the last day for opposing Debtor's and Cancañón's discharge or dischargeability or debts were respectively November 21, 2014 and December 1, 2014, with nothing from the Chapter 7 Trustee or anyone else, notwithstanding the Mr. Román's knowledge of the disassembling of the four (4) model Houses, evidenced by his zero valuation.
- b) Mr. Román's failure to take any now barred actions regarding the

disassembling of the four (4) model Houses under 11 U.S.C. §§547 or 548

There is only one answer to the above, that is that the Chapter 7 Trustee consented to the disassembling of the four (4) model Houses.

By June 2014, due to the negative publicity, Cancañón didn't sell Houses and had no customers. It was then and only then, realizing the impossibility of saving its operations and restructuring its business, that Cancañón by corporate resolution decided that its only option was to file Chapter 7. In order to protect its estate and operations from DACO's predatory tactics and endeavors, Debtor followed suit with its Chapter 11 petition, as testified by Mr. Martínez during Debtor's Section 341 meeting of creditors, considering that other than the improperly filed claims, Debtor has a limited debt structure of the Realty to protect.

It must be underscored that \$427,000.00 of the sale to Furiel were deposited in Debtor's account. \$560,393.00 were deposited and disbursed as indicated above by Cancañón in its supplier Dantzler's account from the sale of the Houses, and that cash disbursements for \$195,854.00 were made to customers by Cancañón for a total of \$1,183,247.00, reflecting Debtor and Cancañón's shareholders and directors' honesty and integrity, and that contrary to any unsupported thoughts that they bilked poor customers and pocketed money, establishing the legitimate use of all available resources.

All efforts were utilized to desperately fight DACO and the media tainted thereby in an attempt to save Cancañón. Moreover, Cancañón's available monetary resources were utilized for the delivery of the maximum number of the Houses from January 2013 until the closing of Cancañón's operations in June 2014; Cancañón delivered Houses totaling \$2,070,698.47. These \$2,070,698.47 sharply contrast with the \$896,923.00

received from the sales of the Houses during that same period.

Not content with the disastrous results of its endeavors, which destroyed Cancañón, and facing the consequence of its acts of preventing Cancañón from continuing its operations and delivering the Houses, as historically done for 30 years, leaving more than 400 persons without the necessary materials, disregarding that Cancañón had employed up to its last cent in delivering all the Houses it could and that there were no other funds, DACO went on against Debtor and Cancañón's officers pressing unfounded criminal charges against Mr. Martínez, being well aware of the civil and contractual relationship between Cancañón and its customers, in respect to which at the time of execution of the corresponding contract, Cancañón delivered to each customer plans and specifications of a \$3,000.00 value.

Mr. Martínez was found not guilty of these frivolous and abusive criminal charges, as further evidenced by Martínez's negative Certificate of Penal Record.

4.2 Debtor's Post-Petition Endeavors.

As a result of the filing of the Chapter 11 petition, Debtor received the benefits of 11 U.S.C. § 362(a), which stayed all collection actions and judicial proceedings against Debtor, providing it with the opportunity to object to the improperly filed duplicative claims and file a Plan and Disclosure Statement, as envisioned by the Bankruptcy Code, without the pressures and the scenario that drove Debtor into Chapter 11. The United States Trustee held the first meeting of creditors pursuant to Section 341 of the Bankruptcy Code in Debtor case on September 22, 2014 and December 22, 2014. (Docket Nos. 15 and 146).

Debtor has undertaken the following efforts for the benefit of its Estate and its creditors:

Debtor sought and obtained the Bankruptcy Court's approval to retain Charles A. Cuprill, PSC Law Offices, as its bankruptcy substitute counsel, and has unsuccessfully attempted to utilize the claims objection process for the elimination of the aforesaid claims in order to be able to move on with its reorganization process.

V. CLAIMS AGAINST DEBTOR

5.1 Claims Against Debtor

Debtor's Allowed Claims, as defined in the Plan, will be entitled to distribution pursuant thereto, as indicated in page 6 hereof.

The Plan provides that only the holders of Allowed Claims, that is, holders of Claims not in dispute, not contingent, liquidated in amount and not subject to objection or estimation are entitled to receive distribution thereunder. Until a claim becomes an Allowed Claim, distribution will not be made to the holder of such claim.

5.2 Objections to Claims

The objections to Claims will be filed, refiled, and served on Holders thereof by the Claims Objection Bar Date, which as set forth in the Plan is the later of the date that such claims become due and payable in accordance with their terms, or thirty (30) days before the first date fixed by the Bankruptcy Court for the hearing on the confirmation of Debtor's Plan. If an objection has not been filed or refiled to a Claim by the Claims Objection Bar Date, the Claim will be treated as an Allowed Claim.

Objections to Claims filed in Debtor's Chapter 11 case are to be prosecuted by Debtor, including any application to estimate or disallow Claims for voting purposes.

What follows is a list of the claims filed against Debtor, as well as those claimants listed by Debtor on its schedules as undisputed, non-contingent and/or liquidated claimants, Debtor's reconciliation of each such claim, indicating those objected to and to

be objected to, including those pending review as to which a renewed objection is to be filed:

VI. DESCRIPTION OF THE PLAN

The following is a summary of the significant provisions of the Plan and is qualified in its entirety by said provisions. A copy of the Plan is being filed simultaneously herewith. In the event and to the extent that the description of the Plan contained in the Disclosure Statement is inconsistent with any provisions of the Plan, the provisions of the Plan shall control and take precedence. All creditors are urged to carefully read the Plan.

6.1 Unclassified Claims

In accordance with Section 1123(a)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code, Administrative Expense Claims and Priority Tax Claims are not classified in the Plan. A description of the unclassified claims and the Claims and Interest in each class, as well as the estimated principal amount thereof as of the Effective Date of the Plan and their treatment, are set forth in the Plan. Administrative Expense Claims are generally the ordinary and necessary costs of administering and operating during a Chapter 11 case.

6.2 Administrative Expense Claims

Except as otherwise agreed to by Debtor and the holder of an Allowed Administrative Expense Claim, each such holder shall be paid in full in the regular course of business or as authorized by the Court on or before the Effective Date of the Plan.

If Debtor disputes any portion of an Administrative Expense Claim, Debtor shall pay such Claim within thirty (30) days after the entry of a Final Order with respect to the allowance of such disputed Administrative Expense Claim.

6.3 Professional Fee Claims

The professionals retained by Debtor in Debtor's Chapter 11 case have and will incur fees and expenses from the date of their retention through the Effective Date of the Plan. It is impossible to predict the amount of professional administrative expense fees that will be incurred through the confirmation of the Plan. As of the filing of this Disclosure Statement, Debtor has paid its Chapter 11 attorneys and its accountant \$30,575.00, in professional fees, of which \$17,000.00 have been paid to attorney Lysette Morales Vidal, \$7,000.00 to Debtor's present attorney, and \$6,575.00 to Debtor's accountant Luis Cruz, CPA.

On April 8, 2015, the Court, in reference to Ms. Morales's application for compensation for a total of \$47,238.765 filed on January 26, 2015, approved \$15,000.00 to be satisfied from the \$15,000.00 retainer already paid. The remaining balance of \$32,238.70 was also approved subject to the filing and approval by the Court, prior to confirmation, of an agreement by Debtor's president and Ms. Morales providing for the payment of the outstanding fees (Docket No. 186). This didn't occur.

Debtor estimates that additional Allowed Professionals Fee Claims, to all professionals, retained by Debtor will add to approximately \$30,000.00, for unpaid

services to be rendered and expenses incurred up to the Confirmation of the Plan.

All amounts paid and to be paid to professionals through the Confirmation Date, including interim fees and expenses are subject to final Bankruptcy Court approval. Debtor reserves the right to contest the allowance of any professional fees.

6.4 Priority Tax Claims

Priority Tax Claims are claims entitled to priority pursuant to Section 507(a)(8) of the Bankruptcy Code. Such Priority Tax Claims consist of taxes accrued prior to the Petition Date, due to Centro de Recaudación de Ingresos Municipales ("CRIM") and the Department of the Treasury of Puerto Rico totaling \$1,618.66.

Holders of Allowed Priority Tax Claims shall be paid in full on the Effective Date of the Plan.

6.5 Classes of Claims and Equity Interest

As of the Petition Date, Debtor had General Unsecured Claims as more particularly described below. The Plan classifies the claims against Debtor. A description of the Class of Claims and the Equity Interest, the estimated principal amount due thereto as of the Effective Date of the Plan and its treatment are set forth below. The Class of Claims and the Interest in Debtor set forth in the Plan are as follows:

Class 1 – Holders of Allowed General Unsecured Claims in the aggregate amount of \$12,973.98. The claims consist of the unsecured portions of the CRIM and the Puerto Rico Department of the Treasury's claims, in the amounts of \$49.98 and \$879.00, respectively; Milagros Luznaris Tarrats's Claim No. 135 (\$4,495.00). and Luz M. Cartagena Ramos's Claim No. 234 (\$7,550.00).

Class 2 - The Equity Interest - The Equity Holder.

6.6 Treatment of Claims.

Class 1 - Holder of Allowed General Unsecured Claims

- (a) Impairment and Voting - Class 1 is unimpaired under the Plan and is not entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan, as it is conclusively presumed to have accepted the Plan pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §1126 (f).
- (b) Treatment - Holders of Allowed General Unsecured Claims will be paid in full on the Effective Date of the Plan.

Class 2 - The Interest of Debtor's Shareholder

- (a) Impairment and Voting - Class 2 is unimpaired under the Plan, is not entitled to vote to accept or reject the Plan, as it is deemed to have accepted the Plan pursuant to 11 USC § 1126 (f).
- (b) Distribution - The Equity Holder will not receive any distribution under the Plan, but will retain his shares in Debtor unaltered.

6.7 Means for Implementation of the Plan

Claims will be paid with available funds arising from Debtor's rent income and the sale of 729.50 square meters of its realty at Urbanización Industrial No. 3, Avenida By Pass, Ponce, PR to Furiel Auto Corp. for \$200.00 per square meter for a total of \$145,900.00.

The aforesaid funds are more than sufficient to pay all creditors in full on the Effective Date of the Plan.

6.8 Cancellation of Existing Agreements

Except to the extent reinstated or unimpaired under this Plan, or for purposes of evidencing a right to distribution under the Plan or as otherwise provided herein, on the Effective Date of the Plan, all agreements and other documents evidencing any Claim or rights of any holder of a Claim against Debtor, including all indentures and notes evidencing such Claims, shall be cancelled.

6.9 Effectuating Documents and Further Transactions

Upon entry of the Confirmation Order, Debtor shall be authorized and instructed to execute, deliver, file or record such contracts, instruments, releases, consents, certificates, resolutions and other agreements and documents and take such actions as may be reasonably necessary or appropriate to effectuate, implement, consummate and further evidence the terms and conditions of the Plan, including, without limitation, implementing all settlements and compromises as set forth in or contemplated by the Plan and performing all obligations under the Plan.

6.10 Authority to Act

Prior to, on or after the Effective Date of the Plan (as appropriate), all matters expressly provided for under the Plan that would otherwise require approval of the stockholder, security holders, officers, directors, partners, managers, members of Debtor shall be deemed to have occurred and shall be in effect prior to, on or after the Effective Date of the Plan (as appropriate) pursuant to the applicable law of Puerto Rico, without any requirement of further vote, consent, approval, authorization or other action by such stockholders, security holders, officers, directors, partners, managers, members of Debtor or notice to, order of or hearing before the Bankruptcy Court.

6.11 Debtor's Post Confirmation Management

After confirmation of the Plan, Debtor will continue with its current management, consisting of its President, Mr. Martínez, and others members of its management team. Mr. Martínez's annual salary is estimated in \$24,000.00.

6.12 Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases

As of the Petition Date, Debtor had lease agreements as lessor with X&X Real Estate d/b/a Casa de los Tornillos for a ten (10) year term, as of November 18, 2014; Omar Pacheco Rios d/b/a Final Touch for a ten (10) year term, as of February 2, 2011; Pedro Santiago d/b/a Santiago Sanitation for a five (5) year term, as of June 30, 2015, and William Rivera for a ten (10) year term, as of March 1, 2008. These lease agreements shall conclusively be deemed assumed by Debtor on the Effective Date. The entry of the Confirmation Order by the Court shall constitute approval of such assumption pursuant to Sections 365(a) and 1123(b)(2) of the Bankruptcy Code.

Any other executory contract which (i) has not expired by its own terms on or prior to the Confirmation Date, (ii) has not been assumed and assigned or rejected with the approval of the Bankruptcy Court on or prior to the Confirmation Date, (iii) is not the subject of a motion to assume or reject which is pending on the Confirmation Date shall be deemed rejected on the Effective Date, and the entry of the Confirmation Order by the Bankruptcy Court shall constitute approval of such rejection pursuant to Sections 365(a) and 1123(b)(2) of the Bankruptcy Code.

If the rejection of any executory contract or unexpired lease results in a claim for damages by the other party or parties to such contract or lease, any claim for such damages, if not evidenced already by a filed proof of claim, shall be forever

barred and shall not be enforceable against the Estate, or its properties or agents, successors, or assigns, unless a proof of claim is filed with the Bankruptcy Court and served upon counsel for Debtor on or before forty-five (45) days following the Confirmation Date. Debtor retains the right to further object to any rejection damages claims filed in accordance with this Section.

6.13 Exculpation

Debtor, and its present and former members, officers, directors, representatives, shareholders, employees, advisors, attorneys and agents acting in such capacity shall have no liability to any Holder of any Claim or the Equity Interest or any other Person for any act taken or omission made after the Petition Date in connection with, or arising out of the captioned case, the Plan, the Disclosure Statement, the solicitation of votes for confirmation of the Plan, the administration of the Plan or Debtor's property distributed under the Plan, or any transaction contemplated by the Plan or the Disclosure Statement in furtherance thereof, except for willful misconduct or gross negligence, as determined by a Final Order of the Court and, in all respects, shall be entitled to rely upon the advice of counsel with respect to their duties and responsibilities under the Plan. Nothing in the Plan shall release, discharge or exculpate any non-Debtor party from any Claim owed to the United States Government or its agencies, including any liability arising under the Internal Revenue Code or criminal laws of the United States.

VII. LIQUIDATION AND FINANCIAL ANALYSIS

7.1 Best Interest of Creditors and Comparison with Chapter 7 Liquidation

The aforesaid reveals that there is no need to compare the Plan with a liquidation scenario since all Allowed Claims are to be paid in full on the Effective Date of the Plan.

The appointment of a Chapter 7 Trustee would only result in unnecessary additional administrative expenses and delays in distribution to creditors.

Confirmation of the Plan will assure that holders of Administrative Expense Claims, Allowed Priority Tax Claims, and General Unsecured Claims will receive prompt dividends on their claims, as set forth above.

7.2 Feasibility of the Plan

A) Funds and Assets Sufficient for Payments Required under the Plan

Debtor has an agreement with Furiel to sell 729.50 square meters of its realty at Urbanización Industrial No. 3, Avenida By Pass, Ponce, PR for \$200.00 per square meter for a total of \$145,900.00, funds which are more than sufficient to meet all payments under the Plan.

7.3 Pending Litigation and Other Liabilities

At the time of the filing of the Chapter 11 petition, Debtor was a party to several administrative proceedings listed in its Amended Statement of Financial Affairs (Docket No. 170). In addition, it is a party to civil proceeding KAC2014-0637, in the Court of First Instance of Puerto Rico, Superior Section of San Juan. Judgment was entered on December 22, 2016, dismissing the Complaint against Mr. Martínez, pending as to other parties.

7.4 Leases and Executory Contracts

As of the Petition Date, Debtor had lease agreements as lessor with X&X Real Estate d/b/a Casa de los Tornillos for a ten (10) year term, as of November 18, 2014; Omar Pacheco Rios d/b/a Final Touch for a ten (10) year term, as of February 2, 2011; Pedro Santiago d/b/a Santiago Sanitation for a five (5) year

term, as of June 30, 2015, and William Rivera for a ten (10) year term, as of March 1, 2008.

VIII. BAR DATE AND DETERMINATION OF CLAIMS

8.1 Bar Date

On August 21, 2014, in the "Notice of Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Case, Meeting of Creditors and Deadlines" issued in Debtor's case the Bankruptcy Court fixed December 22, 2014, as the bar date for the filing of proofs of claims and interests (except for Governmental Units), and February 10, 2015, for such filings by Governmental Units.

8.2 Determination of Claims

The Plan specifies procedures for objecting to claims. Debtor will object to Claims, as indicated above, within thirty (30) days before the first date fixed by the Bankruptcy Court for the hearing on the confirmation of the Plan. No payments will be made under the Plan on account of Disputed Claims until their allowance by the Bankruptcy Court. The Plan provides that Distributions on Disputed Claims will be held in reserve until the Disputed Claims are allowed (at which time the reserves will be distributed and the Claims will be treated according to the terms of the Plan), or disallowed (at which time the reserves will be distributed on account of Allowed Claims pursuant to the terms of the Plan).

Any Claims which (a) are not listed as Allowed Claims on Debtor's Schedules, as amended; (b) are not evidenced by a valid, timely filed Proof of Claim; or (c) are not listed in the Plan as Allowed Claims, shall not receive any distribution of cash or property under the Plan until the same become Allowed Claims, and shall be disallowed and discharged if they are not Allowed by Order of the Bankruptcy Court.

IX. ALTERNATIVES TO THE PLAN

If the Plan is not confirmed and consummated, the alternatives include (a) Debtor's liquidation under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code, (b) dismissal of Debtor's Chapter 11 Case, or (c) the proposal of an alternative plan.

A. Liquidation Under Chapter 7

If a plan cannot be confirmed, the Case may be converted to Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code, and a trustee would be elected or appointed to liquidate Debtor's assets for distribution to creditors in accordance with the priorities established by the Bankruptcy Code.

Debtor believes that conversion of the Case to Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code, considering the costs and expenses of such a proceeding, would result in a substantial loss to Debtor's Estate, particularly considering that the Plan provides for payment in full of all Allowed Claims.

Thus, Debtor believes that the interest of creditors and the goals of Chapter 11 are better served by the confirmation of the Plan.

B. Dismissal of the Case

Dismissal of the Case would likely create substantial problems for all parties involved, including a run to the courthouse by the duplicative claimants, which would result, in an abandonment of the orderly and structured equitable payments provided by the Plan. Therefore, dismissal of the Case is not a viable alternative for creditors.

C. Alternative Plan of Reorganization

If the Plan is not confirmed, at present, Debtor does not foresee a different plan.

Debtor believes that the Plan described herein will provide the greatest and most expeditious return to creditors.

X. TAX EFFECTS

Based on the provisions of the Puerto Rico Internal Revenue Code of 2011, as amended, and the tax provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, Debtor expects that the implementation of the Plan will not have any tax effects, other than any capital gains tax on the sale of the 729.50 square meters to Furiel Auto Corp., which would be paid with the proceeds of the sale, as calculated by Debtor's accountant.

XI. CONCLUSION

Debtor submits that the Plan is fair and reasonable and in the best interests of the Estate and Creditors and offers the best possible recovery for Creditors under the circumstances. Debtor therefore, urges Creditors to vote in favor of the Plan.
