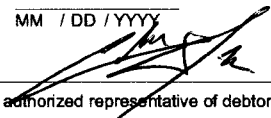

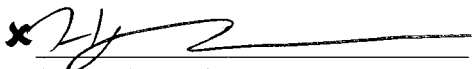

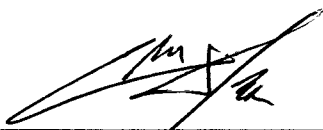
CERTIFICATE OF CORPORATE RESOLUTION

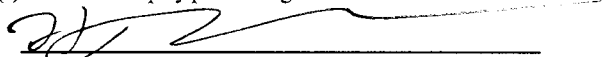
