GENERAL MANDATES TO ISSUE SHARES AND TO REPURCHASE SHARES AND NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

INTRODUCTION

At a meeting of the board of directors of the Company held on 9th June 2005, the Directors announced the audited consolidated results of the Company and its subsidiaries (the "Group") for the year ended 31st March 2005. It was also resolved on the same day that at the annual general meeting to be held on 14th July 2005 ("Annual General Meeting"), resolutions to

grant to the Directors general mandates to issue shares of the Company ("Shares") and to repurchase Shares ("Repurchase Mandate") of the Company will be proposed. The purpose of this circular is to provide shareholders of the Company (the "Shareholders") with details of the proposed general mandates to be dealt with at the Annual General Meeting.

GENERAL MANDATES

At the Annual General Meeting, separate ordinary resolutions will be proposed to renew the general mandates given to the Directors (i) to allot and issue Shares not exceeding the aggregate of 20% of the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital of the Company in issue at the date of the passing of such resolution and Shares representing the aggregate nominal amount (up to a maximum of 10% of the aggregate nominal amount of the Company's then issued share capital as at the date of passing of such resolution) of any Shares repurchased by the Company subsequent to the passing of such resolution; and (ii) to repurchase Shares comprising the aggregate nominal amount of which does not exceed 10% of the aggregate nominal amount of the share capital in issue of the Company at the date of passing of such resolution.

Resolutions Nos. 4 and 5 in the notice of Annual General Meeting will be proposed at the Annual General Meeting to renew these mandates. With reference to these resolutions, the Directors wish to state that they have no present intention to repurchase any Shares pursuant to the relevant mandates.

PROPOSED RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTOR

In accordance with the Company's Bye-laws 86(2) and 87(1), Mr. Kenny King Ching Tam ("Mr. Tam") and Mr. Philip King Huen Ma ("Mr. Ma") will retire by rotation. Mr. Tam and Mr. Ma being eligible, will offer themselves for re-election, at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting respectively.

Particulars of these Directors proposed to be re-elected at the Annual General Meeting are as follows:

Mr. Tam, aged 55, is a Director. Mr. Tam graduated from Concordia University, Canada with a bachelor degree in commerce. He is a qualified accountant in Hong Kong and Canada. Mr. Tam is a practicing accountant in Hong Kong and is the owner of Kenny Tam & Co., Certified Public Accountants. He is also a registered Insolvency Practitioner of the Official Receiver's Office. Mr. Tam has substantial experience in the accounting and insolvency fields. He serves on a number of advisory committees in the Accountancy and Insolvency Profession and has been active in community work in Hong Kong for many years. Mr. Tam is also an independent non-executive director of Shougang Concord Grand (Group) Limited, Kingmaker Footwear Holdings Limited, CCT Telecom Holdings Limited, Starlite Holdings Limited and Van Shung Chong Holdings Limited ("VSC").

Mr. Tam joined the Company as an independent non-executive Director on 30th September 2004 and his emoluments related to the year ended 31st March 2005 were the director's fee of HK\$40,000.

Mr. Ma, aged 48, is a Director. Mr. Ma is the group managing director of The Sincere Company Limited, a listed company on the Stock Exchange. He joined the Company in March 2000. Mr. Ma holds a masters degree in business administration from McMaster University in Canada. Mr. Ma is also very active in his community services and was the Chairman of the Hong Kong Retail Management Association ("HKRMA") from 1996-2000. HKRMA is the major association representing Hong Kong's retail industry with over 600 member companies which employs over 200,000 people.

Mr. Ma's emoluments related to each of the years ended 31st March 2004 and 2005 were the annual director's fee of HK\$10,000.

The director's fee of Directors are determined by the Board with reference to the Directors' contributions and relevant duties and responsibilities within the Company.

Save as disclosed above, as at the Latest Practical Date, Mr. Tam and Mr. Ma do not have any interest in the securities of the Company within the meaning of Part XV of the Securities and Future Ordinance. No service contract has been signed between Mr. Tam and Mr. Ma and the Company and their emoluments will be reviewed annually taking into consideration prevailing market practice. Mr. Tam and Mr. Ma are independent of the directors, chief executives, substantial shareholders of the Company or an associate of any of them.

RIGHT TO DEMAND A POLL

Pursuant to Bye-law 66 of the Bye-laws of the Company, at any general meeting, a resolution put to the vote of the meeting shall be decided on a show of hands unless (before or on the declaration of the result of the show of hands or on the withdrawal of any other demand for a poll) a poll is demanded:

- (a) by the chairman of such meeting; or
- (b) by at least three members present in person (or in the case of a member being a corporation by its duly authorised representative) or by proxy for the time being entitled to vote at the meeting; or
- (c) by a member or members present in person (or in the case of a member being a corporation by its duly authorised representative) or by proxy and representing not less than one-tenth of the total voting rights of all members having the right to vote at the meeting; or
- (d) by a member or members present in person (or in the case of a member being a corporation by its duly authorised representative) or by proxy and holding shares in the Company conferring a right to vote at the meeting being shares on which an aggregate sum has been paid up equal to not less than one-tenth of the total sum paid up on all shares conferring that right.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This is an explanatory statement given to all the Shareholders relating to a resolution to be proposed at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting authorising the Repurchase Mandate.

This explanatory statement contains all the information required pursuant to Rule 13.08 of the GEM Listing Rules which is set out as follows:

1. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 1,596,887,805 Shares of HK\$0.10 each.

Subject to the passing of the resolution in relation to the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no Shares are issued or repurchased by the Company prior to the Annual General Meeting, the Company will be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 159,688,780 Shares, representing 10% of the Shares in issue of HK\$0.10 each.

2. REASONS FOR REPURCHASES

Repurchases of Shares will only be made when the Directors believe that such a repurchase will benefit the Company and its members. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value per Share of the Company and/or its earnings per Share.

3. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

In repurchasing securities, the Company may only apply funds legally available for such purpose in accordance with its memorandum of association and bye-laws, the GEM Listing Rules and the Companies Act 1981 of Bermuda (the "Companies Act"). The Company may not purchase securities on GEM for a consideration other than cash or for settlement otherwise than in accordance with the trading rules of the Stock Exchange from time to time. Under the Companies Act, a company may only repurchase its shares out of capital paid up on the Shares to be repurchased or out of the funds of the company which would otherwise be available for dividend or distribution or out of the proceeds of a fresh issue of shares made for the purpose of the repurchase. 4. GENERAL

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company as compared with the position disclosed in its most recent published audited accounts for the year ended 31st March 2005 in the event that the proposed purchase pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate were to be carried out in full at any time during the proposed purchase period. However, the Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Group or on its gearing levels which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Group.

5. UNDERTAKING

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, they will exercise the power of the Company to make purchase pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the GEM Listing Rules, the memorandum of association and bye-laws of the Company and the applicable laws of Bermuda.

6. TAKEOVER CODE

If as a result of a repurchase of Shares, a shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purpose of the Hong Kong Code on Takeovers and Mergers (the "Code"). As a result, a shareholder, or a group of shareholders acting in concert, depending on the level of increase in the shareholder's interests, could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become(s) obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Code.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, Huge Top Industrial Ltd. ("Huge Top") owns approximately 47.05% of the issued share capital of VSC and Van Shung Chong (B.V.I.) Limited ("VSC BVI") is a wholly-owned subsidiary of VSC. VSC BVI and Huge Top which are the substantial shareholders of the Company, held approximately 18.85% and 10.01% respectively of the issued Shares of the Company. In the event that the Directors exercised in full the power to repurchase Shares of the Company in accordance with the

terms of the ordinary resolution to be proposed at the Annual General Meeting, the total interests of VSC BVI and Huge Top in the Shares of the Company would be increased to approximately 20.95% and 11.12% respectively of the issued Shares of the Company. If so, the Directors will take necessary steps to comply with the GEM Listing Rules and the Takeover Code.
