This is in reference to the news article entitled "PT&T accuses PLDT of blocking calls" published in the December 27, 2002 issue of Today. The article reported that: "THE Philippine Long Distance Telephone Co. (PLDT) has been accused of blocking long-distance calls coming from the Philippine Telegraph and Telephone Co. (PT&T) despite an order from the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC) to restore interconnection between the two telecom companies. Ernesto Barro, PT&T assistant vice president for carrier relations, accused PLDT of deliberately controlling the interconnection between them because the telecom giant does not want to recognize P114 million worth of toll settlement claims it allegedly owes PT&T for 2001. x x x"	
Philippine Long Distance Telephone Company ("TEL"), in a letter to the Exchange dated January 2, 2003, clarified that:

We vehemently deny the report that PLDT has been blocking PT&T traffic. There is also no truth to the report that PLDT owes PT&T toll settlement claims."
