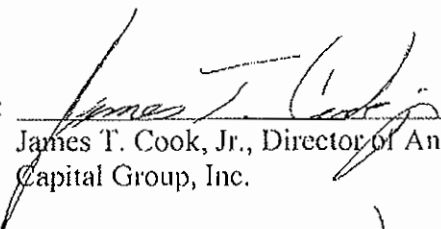

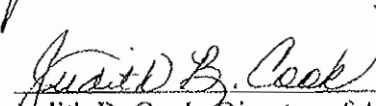
Retention of Professionals
