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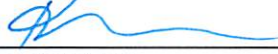

Upon motion duly made and seconded it was unanimously

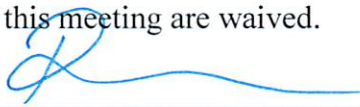
Resolved, that the Company file for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. It was further
