**CONSENT ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS’ MOTION PURSUANT TO
11 U.S.C. § 1121(d) EXTENDING EXCLUSIVE PERIODS IN WHICH
TO FILE A CHAPTER 11 PLAN AND SOLICIT VOTES THEREON**

This matter having come before this Court on the Debtor’s Motion for the entry of an Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1121(d) Extending The Debtors’ Exclusive Period In Which To File a Chapter 11 Plan and To Solicit Votes Thereon [Doc. No. 85] (the “Motion”), and the Court finding that (i) it has jurisdiction over the matters raised in the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (ii) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); (iii) the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates and creditors; (iv) proper and adequate notice of the Motion and the hearing thereon has been given and that no other or further notice is necessary; (v) the single objection to the Motion having been resolved; and (v) upon the record herein, after due deliberation thereon, good and sufficient cause exists for the granting of the relief as set forth herein, it is therefore hereby **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:**

1. Subject to the terms identified herein, the Motion [Doc. No. 85] is GRANTED;
2. The hearing on this Motion scheduled for February 1, 2018 is CANCELLED;
3. The Debtors’ Exclusive Filing Period, as that term is defined in the Motion, is extended from Friday, January 12, 2018, through and until Wednesday, February 28, 2018;

4. The Debtors' Exclusive Solicitation Period, as that term is defined in the Motion, is extended from Tuesday, March 13, 2018, through and until, April 27, 2018;

5. This Order is without prejudice to the Debtors' right to seek additional extensions of the Exclusive Filing Period and Exclusive Solicitation Period, upon notice and a hearing; and

6. This Order is effective immediately upon entry.
