Forke & Tuel Appraisal Services, LLC, and the undersigned Appraiser have not previously appraised or provided any other services concerning the Schedule A list of Equipment or Owner within the last 3 years. The Intended Use of the Appraisal Report is for collateral based lending purposes. The Intended Users of the Appraisal Report are Security State Bank, and its authorized representatives.

PURPOSE OF THIS REPORT

The purpose of this report is to determine the value of the attached Schedule of equipment assets of Hout Fencing, Inc. for collateral based lending purposes.

CHOSEN APPROACH TO VALUATION

Personal Property Appraisal considers the three approaches to value: Cost Approach, Market Approach, and Income Approach. These various approaches to valuation were considered for this report, and after consideration by Security State Bank, the chosen approach to valuation used for this appraisal is **Market Approach**. Cost & Income approaches were considered, but were deemed less relevant to the requirements of the assignment by Security State Bank.

DEFINITION(S) OF APPROACH TO VALUATION

COST APPROACH

The Cost Approach estimates current replacement or reproduction cost of an item minus physical depreciation, functional, and economic obsolescence.

MARKET APPROACH

The Market Approach compares the subject property with similar recently sold properties. In the absence of recent sales, property listed for sale is used to trend market range.

INCOME APPROACH

"The Income Approach is a method to measure the present value of a property's expected future returns. A decision to purchase any property is an investment decision. Investment decisions are made in consideration of the expected return generated from the investment, the period of time over which the return will be earned and the risk of not receiving the expected return." (Source: Valuing Machinery and Equipment: The Fundamentals of Appraising Machinery and Technical Assets, P148)

(Note: With some exceptions, personal property proves difficult to value using an Income Approach. The prediction of a reasonable income depends on readily available market rates and data of similar properties.)

(Note: Cost less depreciation and obsolescence analysis methods are utilized in some limited instances where recent sales comparison data is inconclusive or non-existent.)

CHOSEN METHOD OF VALUATION

Various methods of valuation were considered for this report, including Auction (or “Forced”) Liquidation, Fair Market, and Orderly Liquidation valuations, with definitions outlined below. After consideration by Security State Bank, the chosen method of valuation used for this appraisal is Orderly Liquidation Valuation.

MARKETABILITY

The equipment of Hout Fencing, Inc. is industry accepted brand name fencing, crushing, and construction equipment, trucks, trailers, and support equipment. It is further noted that the assets will have average demand if placed on the open market.

LIMITING CONDITIONS OF APPRAISAL

The values stated in this Appraisal Report are:

- 1) Based on the best judgment of the appraiser given the facts and conditions available at the date of the valuation.
- 2) Intended and limited to the purpose of determining the value of personal property for collateral based lending purposes.
- 3) Stated in gross dollars with no provision for the cost of advertising, appraisal, auctioneer or broker commissions, freight, handling, insurance and refurbishment, and assuming all equipment to be functioning as intended, unless otherwise noted. These costs should be taken into consideration to fully understand the potential net return to the seller.

EXTRAORDINARY ASSUMPTIONS

The Equipment assets are assumed to be in good running order, functioning as intended, and appraised as such (unless otherwise described as “Parts Only”), and refurbished to normal auction or “rent ready” standards for sale.

The Equipment assets are assumed to be marketable, free and clear of any encumbrances.

For purposes of this valuation analysis and report, it was assumed that a 6 month timeframe would be adequate to conduct an Orderly Liquidation of the assets, as of the effective date of this report.

The refurbishing referred to above assumes cosmetic work such as metalwork, cleaning and painting, and any tire and undercarriage upgrades necessary to get the equipment prepared cosmetically to “auction” or “rent ready” condition would be conducted by the owner. Cosmetic and mechanical work or repairs and/or transportation costs assumed necessary (in order to deliver the equipment to auction or “rent ready” condition) are not included in this report (unless requested by the intended user).

If found false, the findings and conclusions of this Appraisal could be altered.

ATTACHMENTS/DESCRIPTIONS

An itemized list with descriptions is included in Schedule A attached to this report.

SCOPE OF WORK

The equipment was field inspected by the appraiser, as available, based on the inventory list provided by Security State Bank on August 30, 2017, and reviewed by the owner, including approximately 262 equipment assets located in various locations, in and around Worland, Douglas, and Cheyenne, Wyoming.

Field inspections included a physical, "walk by", visual inspection of each item, including verification (to the extent possible) of make, model, VIN numbers, configuration of the equipment assets including listing features and attachments, and relative visual condition of the asset itself, as well as wear components including tires and undercarriages. No attempt was made to start or operate the equipment assets inspected, unless otherwise noted.

Write ups for each equipment asset, as available, were conducted in the field, along with taking digital pictures of each asset to verify appearance at the time of inspection, as well as for review and archival purposes.

Conditions of the Equipment assets are generally defined as either "Excellent", "Very Good", "Good", "Fair", "Poor", or "Parts Only" (see definition of "Physical Conditions" terms).

Any item(s) not viewed are indicated by an asterisk (*).

An analysis was then conducted under a methodology for valuation utilizing an Orderly Liquidation Valuation method, and using a "Sales Comparison Approach" (also referred to as "Market Approach"). Comparisons were conducted with similar equipment from historical auction and/or retail sales utilizing the most current examples available.
