**CERTIFICATION OF THE GARDEN CITY GROUP, INC.  
WITH RESPECT TO SOLICITATION AND TABULATION  
OF VOTES ON DEBTORS' JOINT PREPACKAGED PLAN OF  
REORGANIZATION UNDER CHAPTER 11 OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE**

I, Jeffrey S. Stein, hereby certify, under the penalty of perjury:

1. I am over 18 years of age and a Vice President of The Garden City Group, Inc. ("GCG"), a chapter 11 bankruptcy claims, noticing, and balloting agent located at 105 Maxess Road, Melville, NY 11747.

2. GCG is the noticing, claims, and balloting agent (the "Voting Agent") designated by Xerium Technologies, Inc. ("Xerium") and certain of its direct and indirect subsidiaries (collectively with Xerium, the "Debtors") to (i) assist in the dissemination of solicitation materials to the holders of claims against the Debtors entitled to vote to accept or reject the Debtors' Joint Prepackaged Plan of Reorganization Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (the "Plan"),<sup>2</sup> attached as Exhibit A to the Disclosure Statement, dated March 2, 2010 (as

supplemented, the “Disclosure Statement”) filed contemporaneously herewith, and (ii) to receive and tabulate the ballots cast to accept or reject the Plan.

3. I have 27 years experience in bankruptcy voting procedures and have conducted vote solicitations and vote tabulations in more than 65 chapter 11 cases in this jurisdiction and elsewhere.

4. I am authorized to submit this certification on behalf of GCG. Unless otherwise stated, I have personal knowledge of the facts hereinafter set forth, and if called as a witness, I could and would testify competently thereto.

#### **Distribution of Solicitation Packages**

5. Under the Plan, holders of claims of Class 2 (Shared Collateral Claims) and Class 5 (Unsecured Swap Termination Claims) (collectively, the “Voting Classes”) are entitled to vote on the Plan (such holders, the “Voting Parties”). As set forth in the Disclosure Statement, the Debtors established February 23, 2010 as the record date (the “Record Date”) for determining the Voting Parties.

6. On March 2, 2010, in accordance with the procedures for the solicitation and tabulation of votes established by the Debtors in the Disclosure Statement (the “Solicitation Procedures”) and as set forth herein, I supervised and caused sufficient copies of the solicitation materials identified below (collectively, the “Solicitation Package”) to be distributed to the Voting Parties listed in Exhibit A attached hereto. The Solicitation Packages were distributed via (i) hand delivery (same-day) to the Voting Parties listed on Exhibit B attached hereto, (ii) Federal Express Priority (overnight) delivery to the Voting Parties located within the United States listed on Exhibit C attached hereto, and (iii) Federal Express Priority delivery to the Voting Parties located

outside of the United States listed on Exhibit D attached hereto.<sup>3</sup> A letter from the Chairman, President and Chief Executive Officer of the Debtors, attached hereto as Exhibit E, was distributed along with the Solicitation Packages, which included the following materials:

- (a) the Disclosure Statement, including all exhibits thereto (including, but not limited to, the Plan);
- (b) as applicable, a ballot to vote Class 2 Credit Facility Claims, Class 2 Secured Swap Termination Claims, or Class 5 Unsecured Swap Termination Claims, in the forms attached hereto as Exhibit F (the “Ballots”); and
- (c) a pre-addressed postage-paid Federal Express Priority return envelope (the “Return Envelope”).

7. I also supervised and caused a notification email to be sent to those Voting Parties for which an email address was provided. A copy of the notification email, including the email addresses to which it was sent is attached hereto as Exhibit G.

8. On March 8, 2010, in accordance with the Solicitation Procedures, I supervised and caused sufficient copies of the Supplement to Disclosure Statement, dated March 8, 2010 (the “Disclosure Statement Supplement”) to be distributed to the Voting Parties listed in Exhibit A attached hereto. The Disclosure Statement Supplement was distributed via (i) hand delivery (same-day) to the Voting Parties listed on Exhibit B attached hereto, (ii) Federal Express Priority (overnight) delivery to the Voting Parties located within the United States listed on Exhibit C attached hereto, and (iii) Federal Express Priority delivery to the Voting Parties located outside of the United States listed on Exhibit D attached hereto.

### Vote Certification

9. GCG was designated by the Debtors to receive the Ballots and tabulate the Voting Parties' votes on the Plan. I supervised the tabulation of votes by personnel of GCG in accordance with the Solicitation Procedures.

10. Ballots returned in Return Envelopes, or otherwise by mail or hand delivery, were received by personnel of GCG at the offices of GCG in Dublin, Ohio, where GCG's mail processing operations are centralized. All Ballots received were date- and time-stamped upon receipt.

11. As described in the Disclosure Statement, for a Ballot to be counted as valid, the Ballot must have been properly completed and executed by the holder of a claim in one of the Voting Classes, or such holder's authorized representative, and received by GCG by 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern Time) on March 22, 2010, subject to the Debtors' right to extend the voting period.

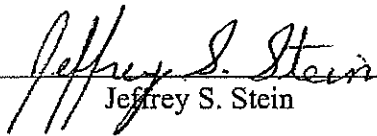
12. Ultimately, to accommodate holders that had expressed an interest in voting but whose Ballots had not been received as of March 22, 2010, including foreign voters, the Debtors instructed GCG to accept all Ballots received through March 26, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) (the "Voting Deadline").

13. All Ballots cast by the Voting Parties were validly executed, received by GCG on or before the Voting Deadline, and tabulated as outlined in the Disclosure Statement Order. Accordingly, other than Ballots superseded by subsequent Ballots submitted, no Ballots received by GCG were excluded from the final tabulation of votes cast by the Voting Parties.

14. I hereby certify that the voting results are as set forth in the tables attached hereto as Exhibit H, which is a true and correct copy of the final tabulation of votes cast on timely and properly completed Ballots received by GCG.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief.

("Xerium"); Huyck Licensco Inc.; Stowe Woodward Licensco LLC; Stowe Woodward LLC; Wangner Itelpa I LLC; Wangner Itelpa II LLC; Weavexx, LLC; Xerium Asia, LLC; Xerium III (US) Limited; Xerium IV (US) Limited; Xerium V (US) Limited; XTI LLC; Xerium Canada Inc.; Huyck.Wangner Austria GmbH; Xerium Germany Holding GmbH; and Xerium Italia S.p.A.
